RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-964-22

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXPLORE
ESTABLISHING RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE
PROFESSIONAL SPORTS TEAMS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY
TO HOST MONTHLY BREAKFASTS WITH LOCAL
SCHOOL CHILDREN; AND REQUIRING A REPORT

WHEREAS, there are several professional sports teams in Miami-Dade County,
including the Miami Dolphins, the Miami Heat, Miami Marlins, and Inter Miami CF; and

WHEREAS, schoolchildren often admire professional athletes; and

WHEREAS, athletes can be role models for children; and

WHEREAS, establishing a relationship between the community and the professional
sports teams can benefit both the athletes and the community; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously had relationships with professional teams to
encourage relationships between players and children; and

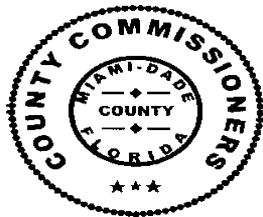
WHEREAS, hosting monthly breakfasts with school children and professional athletes
could also serve as an incentive for children to perform well in school and keep active,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board hereby directs
the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to, within 30 days of the effective date of this
resolution, prepare a written report regarding the feasibility of establishing and hosting a monthly
breakfast with local professional athletes and school children. The report shall include the
anticipated fiscal impact of such a program, possible revenue sources, and suggested County
locations for the monthly breakfasts. The completed report Board shall be placed directly on an
agenda of the full Board without committee review in accordance with Ordinance No. 14-65.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator Javier D. Souto. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Keon Hardemon** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
