RESOLUTION APPOINTING NADEIGE THERESIAS-JOISIL
TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE N.W. 7TH
AVENUE CORRIDOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 163.356,
FLORIDA STATUTES, AND SECTION 2-1889 OF THE CODE
OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (“Board”), as the governing body, as that term is defined in section 163.340(3), Florida Statutes, is responsible for appointing the board of commissioners of the members of the N.W. 7th Avenue Corridor Community Redevelopment Agency (“Agency”); and

WHEREAS, this Board adopted Ordinance No. 06-18, which created the Agency and appointed an initial board of commissioners (“Agency’s Board”) pursuant to section 163.356, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 163.356(2), Florida Statutes, each appointed commissioner other than those initially appointed shall serve a term of four years; and

WHEREAS, section 163.356(3)(b) states that: “[a]ny person may be appointed as commissioner if he or she resides or is engaged in business, which means owning a business, practicing a profession, or performing a service for compensation, or serving as an officer or director of a corporation or other business entity so engaged, within the area of operation of the agency, which shall be coterminous with the area of operation of the county... and is otherwise eligible for such appointment...;” and

WHEREAS, Nadeige Thererias-Joisil is a resident of Miami-Dade County and has applied to this Board to be appointed to the Agency’s Board; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed Nadeige Theresias-Joisil’s resume, which is attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, this Board believes that based on Nadeige Theresias-Joisil’s resume, she has the requisite experience that is required to serve on the Agency’s Board; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, in accordance with section 163.356, Florida Statutes, and section 2-1889 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, this Board desires to appoint Nadeige Theresias-Joisil, who shall serve a four-year term,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

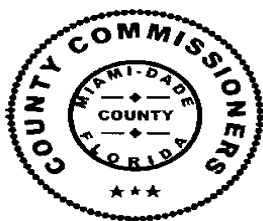
Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. This Board appoints Nadeige Theresias-Joisil to the board of commissioners of the N.W. 7th Avenue Corridor Community Redevelopment Agency in accordance with section 163.356, Florida Statutes, and section 2-1889 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. In accordance with section 163.356(2), Florida Statutes, and section 2-1883 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, Nadeige Theresias-Joisil shall serve a term of four years.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Jean Monestime. It was offered by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Keon Hardemon** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
