Subject: Recommendation to Waive Competitive Bidding Procedures and Approval of
Additional Expenditure Authority under Contract No. FB-01230, Armored Car
Services

Resolution No. R-1167-22

Summary

This item seeks approval to modify the contract to include language to allow for annual upward or downward price adjustments, as well as approval of \$102,343 in additional expenditure authority to increase the contract rates. The current contract was awarded with a firm and fixed price for a five-year period and price adjustment provisions were not included. It is in the County's best interest to add the price adjustment provision to continue contracting these services which protect the County's funds, including cash, checks, and money orders, during transit to various bank locations by providing adequate equipment and personnel to perform armored car services. The requested increase in allocation is based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and is necessary to ensure continuity of these essential countywide armored car services through contract expiration.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) waive competitive bidding procedures by two-thirds vote of the Board members present pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (Code) and Section 5.03(d) of the Home Rule Charter under *Contract No. FB-01230 Armored Car Services*, for various County Departments. Approval of a bid waiver is needed to modify the contract language to include a price adjustment provision and authorize additional expenditure authority of \$102,343 to increase the contract rates. The County awarded this competitively established contract through Resolution No. R-634-20 for a five-year term on July 8, 2020.

Background

County departments use this contract for the pick-up and delivery of funds (cash, checks, money orders, credit card slips, and other securities) from multiple County locations and frequencies per week, to various bank locations. The County has one way and round-trip pick-up/delivery, for approximately 119 locations, occurring twice weekly to five-days per week. The vendor maintains an adequate number of armored trucks used for transportation of shipments, and provides properly licensed security officers, with valid class "D" security and valid class "G" firearm licenses.

The vendor requested an upward price adjustment of approximately 19 percent; however, under the terms of the contract, the prices are firm and fixed for the five-year term of the contract. This upward price adjustment was requested due to the recent changes in the nation's economy that have resulted in increases in operational costs in the transportation industry, specifically in the area of fuel, and insurance. County staff conducted an analysis of changes in the industry, including review of the applicable CPI for the past one-year period. The CPI shows an 11 percent price change in the past year, thus, it has been determined that an 11 percent price adjustment is fair and reasonable, changing the price per pick-up from \$25.95 to \$28.80 (11 percent), approximately \$35,958 for the first 12 months, effective on November 1, 2022 if approved by the Board.

Approval of a bid waiver in lieu of a new competitive process is requested as this is a very niche market and a new solicitation may not result in better rates for the County since price fluctuations are industry wide. The County received two bids in response to competition for the current contract, and only one proposal was deemed responsive. Additionally, for price comparison purposes, the rate per pick-up for the City of Miami Beach, Monday through Friday, for eight locations is \$28 during business hours and \$35 after hours. City of Miami accesses the City of West Palm Beach contract with a rate of \$1,343 for monthly pick-ups, five days per week at two locations (or an average of \$33 per pick-up). The County will continue to monitor the CPI on an annual basis to determine if any future upward or downward adjustment is applicable. Accordingly, it is in the County's best interest to waive competitive bidding requirements pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the Code and Section 5.03(d) of the Home Rule Charter to allow for the continuation of these essential services.

Scope

The impact of this item is countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The five-year contract term expires on August 31, 2025. The contract has a current cumulative allocation of \$1,982,356. If this request is approved, the cumulative allocation will be \$2,084,699. The requested \$102,343 includes \$35,958 for the first 12-month period. The subsequent adjustments will be based on changes to the CPI.

Delegated Authority

If this item is approved the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee will have the authority to exercise all provisions of the contract, including any future price adjustments, cancellation or extensions, pursuant to Section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38; and execute the modification with the requested upward price adjustment.

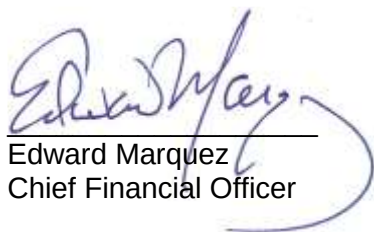

Due Diligence

Pursuant to Resolution No. R-187-12, due diligence was conducted in accordance with the Internal Services Department's Procurement Guidelines to determine contractor responsibility, including verifying corporate status and review of performance and compliance issues through various vendor responsibility lists and a keyword internet search. The lists referenced include convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federal excluded parties. There were no adverse findings relating to IBI International Logistics, Inc. responsibility. However, the CEO of Transvalue, Inc. was charged in June 2021 in a money laundry conspiracy that would have occurred during 2015 and 2016. The county met with Transvalue, Inc. to discuss the allegations, and was advised of the company's reorganization. Transvalue, Inc. provided financial statements and reassured the County that there would be no operational impact to the contract.

Applicable Ordinances and Contract Measures

- The two percent User Access Program provision applies where permitted by funding source.
- The Small Business Enterprise Bid Preference and Local Preference were applied in accordance with the ordinances.
- The Living Wage does not apply as the services are not covered by the Ordinance.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WAIVER OF FORMAL BID PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO SECTION 5.03(D) OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER AND SECTION 2-8.1 OF THE COUNTY CODE BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT; APPROVING CONTRACT MODIFICATION NO. 17 AND INCREASING ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY FOR IBI INTERNATIONAL LOGISTICS, INC. (FORMERLY TRANSVALUE, INC.) IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$102,343.00, FOR A MODIFIED TOTAL CONTRACT AWARD OF \$2,084,699.00 FOR CONTRACT NO. 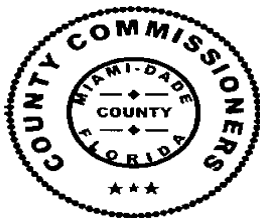
Section 1. This Board finds it is in the best interest of Miami-Dade County to approve Contract Modification No. 17, in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof, and increase additional expenditure authority for IBI International Logistics, Inc. (formerly Transvalue, Inc.) in an amount up to \$102,343.00, for a modified total contract award of \$2,084,699.00 for Contract No. FB-01230 for the purchase of armored car services for various County Departments, pursuant to section 5.03(d) of the Home Rule Charter and section 2-8.1 of the County Code, by a two-thirds vote of the Board Members present.

Section 2. This Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute the contract modification with the requested upward price adjustment and exercise all provisions of the contract, including any future price adjustments, extension or cancellation provisions, pursuant to section 2-8.1 of the County Code and Implementing Order 3-38. CONTRACT MODIFICATION NO. 17

Contract Number: FB-01230 Title: Armored Car Services

Pursuant to Section 1.0, General Terms and Conditions, Paragraph 1.24, titled Modification of Contract, amends the above referenced Contract awarded to **IBI International Logistics, Inc.** by Miami-Dade County (County).

It is mutually understood and agreed by and between the County and **IBI International Logistics, Inc.** that the contract shall be modified as follows effective November 01, 2022, and is contingent upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners:

1. Section 2.6, titled Prices is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the below:

The County may consider an adjustment to price based on changes in the following pricing index: Consumer Price Index (CPI-U), All Urban Consumers, Not Seasonally Adjusted, Miami, Fort Lauderdale, West Palm Beach Area, Series Id: CUURS35BSAOL5, on a year-by-year basis, all items less medical care.

The County reserves the right to negotiate lower pricing based on market research information or other factors that influence price. The County reserves the right to apply any reduction in pricing for the additional 12 month period based on the downward movement of the applicable index.

It is the Awarded Bidder's responsibility to request any pricing adjustment under this provision. The Awarded Bidder's request for adjustment shall be submitted 30 days prior to November 1, of the then current twelve month period within the contract term.

If no adjustment request is received from the Awarded Bidder, the County will assume that the Awarded Bidder has agreed that the subsequent twelve month period within the contract term may be implemented without pricing adjustment. Any adjustment request received after the commencement of a new contract term may not be considered. The County reserves the right to reject any price adjustments submitted by the Awarded Bidder based on such price adjustments, if not in accordance with the above index.

Additional charges of any kind added to the invoice submitted by the bidder is prohibited.

2. The Pricing and Frequency of Pick-up information included in the contract is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment A – Revised Pricing and Frequency of Pick-up.

All terms, covenants and conditions of the original Contract and any modifications issued thereto shall remain in full force and effect, except to the extent herein amended.

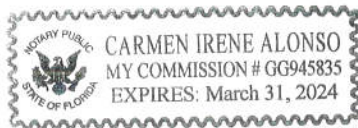
