RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE OCTOBER 15 AND 16, 2022 “8TH ANNUAL REDLAND GROWFEST” SPONSORED BY THE BEE HEAVEN FARM IN AN AMOUNT OF \$4,400.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 8 FY 2022-23 IN-KIND RESERVE

WHEREAS, the Bee Heaven Farm has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the October 15 and 16, 2022 “8th Annual Redland GrowFest” at Fruit & Spice Park in an amount of \$4,400.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and

WHEREAS, Bee Heaven Farm is a certified organic, five-acre, diversified family farm located in the Redland agricultural area south of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the “8th Annual Redland GrowFest” supports the local economy and promotes local businesses; and

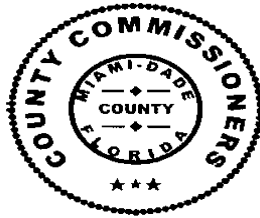
WHEREAS, the “8th Annual Redland GrowFest” is a special event, as that term is defined in the attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application, and \$4,400.00 of the in-kind services shall be funded from the balance of the District 8 FY 2022-23 In-Kind Reserve,

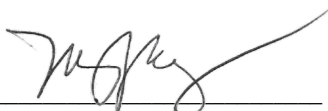

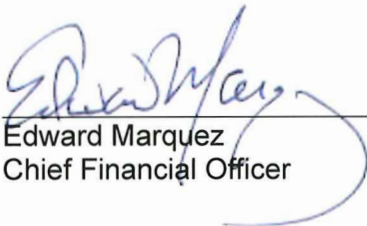
