RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO (1) ELIMINATE PARKING FEES DURING WORKING HOURS AT COUNTY OWNED AND OPERATED PARKING FACILITIES FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICES OF THE STATE ATTORNEY AND PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR THE 11TH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA, AND (2) IDENTIFY LEGALLY AVAILABLE FUNDING TO OFFSET ANY FISCAL IMPACT RESULTING FROM THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS DIRECTIVE

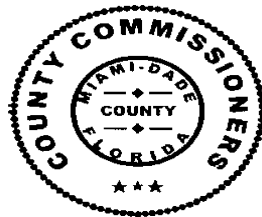
WHEREAS, at the November 15, 2022 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made to direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to eliminate parking fees during working hours at County owned and operated parking facilities for the employees of the Offices of the State Attorney and Public Defender, and direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to identify legally available funding to offset any fiscal impact from the implementation of this directive, and if such funds are not available in FY 2022-2023, funds shall be allocated in the FY 2023-2024 budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to eliminate parking fees during working hours at County owned and operated parking facilities for the employees of the Offices of the State Attorney and Public Defender for the 11th Judicial Circuit of Florida. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall identify legally available funding to offset any fiscal impact from the implementation of this directive, and if such funds are not available in FY 2022-2023, funds shall be allocated in the FY 2023-2024 budget.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Jose “Pepe” Diaz. It was offered by Commissioner **José "Pepe" Diaz**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote the vote was as follows:
