Section 1. Amends prior Board action to recapture the following funds from the FY 2021-22 District 12 Designated Project Program:

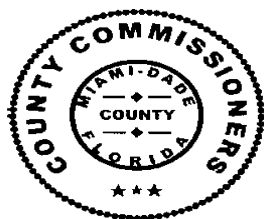
Marine Toys for Tots Foundation \$100,0000.00.
