RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR
THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF INTERACTIVE
DIGITAL TOUCH SCREENS AT COUNTY OWNED AND
OPERATED AREAWIDE PARKS AND REQUIRING A
REPORT

WHEREAS, County areawide parks are the largest parks in the County, hosting millions of visitors each year; and

WHEREAS, there are many areawide County parks that host a variety of events and have a plethora of facilities and uses; and

WHEREAS, it would be helpful for visitors to the areawide parks to be have maps of the park along with listings of events and facilities; and

WHEREAS, there are other municipalities such as the City of Miami and the City of Coral Gables that have utilized similar interactive digital touch screens in certain high pedestrian traffic areas to inform the public of the surrounding environment and neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, there may be entities who would be willing to sponsor the installation of the interactive digital touch screens; and

WHEREAS, there may be funding available in the FY 2022-23 budget to allow for the purchase and installation of interactive digital touchscreens; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to enhance visitors' experience to areawide parks by making them aware of all that the parks have to offer,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

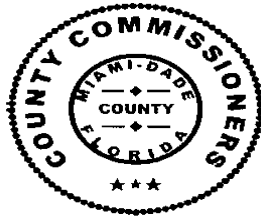
Section 1. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to develop a plan for purchase and installation of interactive digital touch screens to provide park information at County-owned and operated areawide parks.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a report to this Board within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution and place the completed report on an agenda of the full Board without committee review pursuant to rule 5.06(j) of the Board's Rules of Procedure. The report shall include at a minimum, the projected cost of the purchase and installation of interactive digital touch screens, possible funding sources, and possible sponsorship opportunities.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice Chairman Anthony Rodríguez. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Marleine Bastein** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
