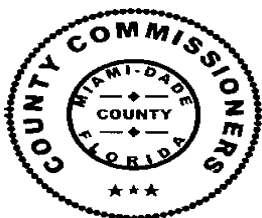
WHEREAS, this Board desires to allocate and rescind funds from the FY 2021-22 District
