RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-438-23

RESOLUTION DECLARING MAY OF 2023 AND THE MONTH OF MAY OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER AS MUSEUM MONTH IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO COORDINATE EVENTS WITH THE GREATER MIAMI CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU AND TO BRAND SUCH EVENTS AS MUSEUM MONTH

WHEREAS, Miami Attraction & Museum Months is a program hosted by the Greater Miami Convention & Visitors Bureau (GMCVB) during April and May that encourages visits to Miami-Dade's many museums; and

WHEREAS, the GMCVB offers discounted admissions to several of Miami-Dade's most famous museums during Miami Attraction & Museum Months, including the Phillip and Patricia Frost Museum of Science and the Deering Estate; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade is home to many world-class museums, such as the Pérez Art Museum Miami, Vizcaya Museum and Gardens, the Miami Children's Museum, and the Jewish Museum of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade's Museum Month would bring attention to the County's various art, history, and science museums and would provide opportunities for locals and visitors to learn from these institutions; and

WHEREAS, the GMCVB has successfully partnered with Miami-Dade County in the past to coordinate programming; and

WHEREAS, the Board seeks to promote the educational opportunities afforded by the County’s museums by coordinating museum-centered events with the GMCVB and branding these events as Museum Month,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

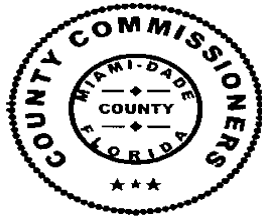
Section 1. Hereby declares May of 2023 and the month of May of each year thereafter as Museum Month in Miami-Dade County.

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s Designee to coordinate events with the Greater Miami Convention & Visitors Bureau that showcase Miami-Dade’s museums and to brand such events as Museum Month.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
