RESOLUTION DECLARING ONE 2005 CHEVROLET COLORADO SURPLUS; AUTHORIZING ITS DONATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR USE IN BILL BAGGS CAPE FLORIDA STATE PARK IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE FOREGOING

WHEREAS, the vehicle described below is owned by Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle is obsolete, its continued usage by Miami-Dade County is uneconomical and inefficient, and the vehicle serves no useful purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (the "Donee") is a governmental unit under section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (the "Code") and operates the Bill Baggs Cape Florida State Park in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the Donee desires to use the vehicle only in Miami-Dade County to enhance its ability to provide services to its constituents for the purposes outlined in the attached Surplus Property Application; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's Internal Services Department has complied with the requirements of section 2-11.2.1 of the Code by offering the vehicle to other Miami-Dade County departments and agencies, none of which accepted the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle is eligible for donation under section 274.05, Florida Statutes, and section 2-11.2.1 of the Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board declares the following vehicle, with the listed residual value and other characteristics, to be surplus pursuant to section 274.05, Florida Statutes, and section 2-11.2.1 of the Code:

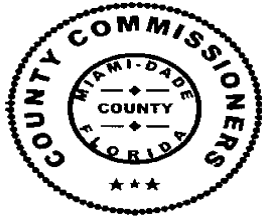
Section 2. This Board authorizes donation of the vehicle to the Donee for use in Bill Baggs Cape Florida State Park in Miami-Dade County, as outlined in the attached Surplus Property Application. The Donee shall take possession of the vehicle within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution. The Donee shall be responsible for any and all costs of transferring the vehicle. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall and is hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 3. If, for any reason, the Donee fails to take possession of the vehicle within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution or fails to transfer title, then this resolution shall be null and void, and the ownership rights to the vehicle shall remain with the County.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
