RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-338-23

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF EAST 4TH
STREET BETWEEN EAST 4TH AVENUE AND EAST 6TH
AVENUE AS “EAGLES WAY”

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2023, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah adopted Resolution No. 2023-028, which codesignated the portion of East 4th Street between East 4th Avenue and East 6th Avenue in the City of Hialeah as “Eagles Way”, in honor of the fifth-grade class of St. John the Apostle School; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. 2023-028 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, St. John the Apostle School (“St. John’s”) was established in the City of Hialeah in 1949 and was the first Catholic school in the city; and

WHEREAS, St. John’s welcomed the students who were a part of the first great influx of Cuban families in the 1960s; and

WHEREAS, St. John’s has continued to serve the community by providing an exceptional Catholic education; and

WHEREAS, many of the children and grandchildren of these first Cuban immigrants attend St. John’s today in continuation of the legacy begun 74 years earlier; and

WHEREAS, St. John’s is located at 479 East 4th Street in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor St. John’s and the school’s contributions to the community by approving the City of Hialeah’s codesignation of that portion of East 4th Street between East 4th Avenue and East 6th Avenue as “Eagles Way”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of East 4th Street between East 4th Avenue and East 6th Avenue is a city-maintained street located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

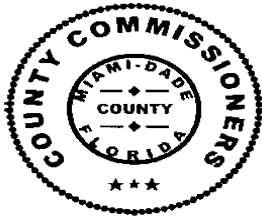
Section 1. Approves the City of Hialeah codesignation of that portion of East 4th Street between East 4th Avenue and East 6th Avenue as “Eagles Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Hialeah Police Department, and the Hialeah Fire Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Kevin Marino Cabrera. It was offered by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-028

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE NAMING OF EAST 4 STREET BETWEEN EAST 4 AVENUE AND EAST 6 AVENUE AS “EAGLES WAY”, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY, IN HONOR OF THE FIFTH GRADE CLASS OF ST. JOHN THE APOSTLE SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, St. John the Apostle School was established in the City of Hialeah in 1949, and was the first Catholic school in the city; and

WHEREAS, St. John’s welcomed the students who were a part of the first great Cuban influx of Cuban families in the 1960’s; and

WHEREAS, St. John’s continues to serve the community by providing an exceptional Catholic education; and

WHEREAS, many of the children and grandchildren of these first Cuban immigrants attend St. John’s and continue the legacy begun 74 years prior; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council would like to honor the Fifth-grade class of St. John’s by co-designating along with Miami-Dade County, that portion of East 4 Street between East 4 Avenue and East 6 Avenue be named as “Eagles Way”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of East 4 Street between East 4 Avenue and East 6 Avenue is a road located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, this proposed designation is located in County Commission District 6; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2023, the City of Hialeah Historic Preservation Board passed Resolution No. 2023-001 recommending the naming.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: That a portion of East 4 Street between East 4 Avenue and East 6 Avenue shall be known as “Eagles Way”, with the cost of signage to be paid by the City, in honor of the Fifth-grade Class of St. John the Apostle School.

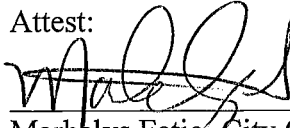
Section 2: The City Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the Mayor and Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners.

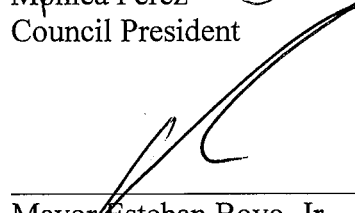

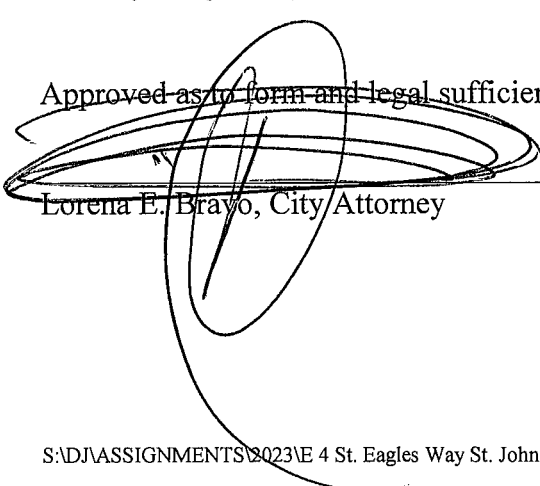
