RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF MEDLEY'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF NW 69TH
AVENUE BETWEEN NORTHWEST SOUTH RIVER DRIVE
AND NORTHWEST 74TH STREET AS "MIAMI POWER TEAM
FOUNDATION AVENUE"

WHEREAS, the Town of Medley (the "Town") passed Resolution Number C-2007 on June 6, 2022, which codesignated the portion of Northwest 69th Avenue within the Town as "Miami Power Team Foundation Avenue," pursuant to a street naming rights agreement with the Miami Power Team Foundation Inc.; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution Number C-2007 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Town maintains the portion of Northwest 69th Avenue between Northwest South River Drive and Northwest 74th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Town would like for the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 12,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the Town of Medley's codesignation of that portion of Northwest 69th Avenue between Northwest South River Drive and Northwest 74th Street as "Miami Power Team Foundation Avenue."

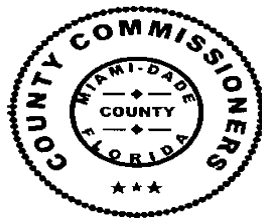
Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Town Council of the Town of Medley, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals

and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resource Department, the Medley Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

RESOLUTION C-2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MEDLEY, FLORIDA, TO APPROVE A STREET NAMING HONORING MIAMI POWER TEAM FOUNDATION INC.; NAMING N.W. 69TH AVE TO BE CO-DESIGNATED AND RENAMED AS "MIAMI POWER TEAM FOUNDATION AVENUE"; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 2nd, 2022, the Town of Medley Council approved a Street Naming honoring Miami Power Team Foundation Inc. ("Original Sponsor") in order to co-designate and rename N.W. 69th Avenue as "Miami Power Team Foundation Avenue", subject to the approval of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Miami Power Team is a Not For Profit Organization that gives hope and extends a helping hand to children who suffer from cancer, other terminal illness and autism;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town Medley, Florida wishes to honor Miami Power Team Foundation because of their tireless efforts to make lives better for children in need;

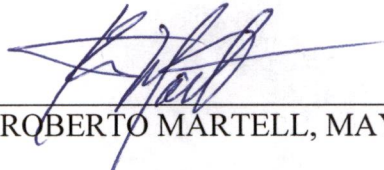

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effective immediately upon passage.

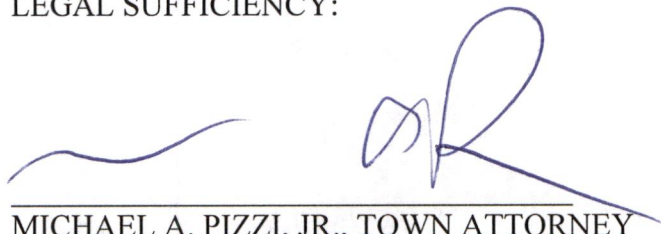
