FLORIDA ENTITIES TO KEEP THE ELEVENTH JUDICIAL
CIRCUIT COURT AS IS AND SERVING ONLY MIAMI-DADE
COUNTY**

WHEREAS, at the October 3, 2023 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made urging all relevant State of Florida entities to keep the Eleventh Judicial Circuit Court as is and serving only Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges all relevant State of Florida entities to keep the Eleventh Judicial Circuit Court as is and serving only Miami-Dade County.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, the Senate President, the House Speaker, the Chair of the Senate Judiciary Committee, the Chair of the House Judiciary Committee, the Honorable Chief Justice and Associate Justices of the Florida Supreme Court, the Florida Supreme Court's Judicial Circuit Assessment Committee, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Eileen Higgins. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Kevin Marino Cabrera** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
