RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-235-18 TO REQUIRE THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A WRITTEN REPORT TO EACH COUNTY COMMISSIONER PERTAINING TO ANY TRANSIT FARE OR SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-150(C) OR 2-150(D) OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, PRIOR TO THE ALREADY REQUIRED PLACEMENT OF SAID REPORT ON AN AGENDA OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION AND SAID REPORT SHALL BE TRANSMITTED TO EACH COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE NO LESS THAN 60 DAYS PRIOR TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ANY SUCH TRANSIT FARE OR SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS

WHEREAS, at the November 7, 2023 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made to amend Resolution No. R-235-18 to require the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a written report to each County Commissioner pertaining to any transit fare or service adjustments made pursuant to section 2-150(c) or 2-150(d) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, prior to the already required placement of said report on an agenda of the County Commission and said report shall be transmitted to each Commissioner's office no less than 60 days prior to the implementation of any such transit fare or service adjustments,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board amends Resolution No. R-235-18 to require the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a written report to each County Commissioner pertaining to any transit fare or service adjustments made pursuant to section 2-150(c) or 2-150(d) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, prior to the already required placement of said report on an agenda of the County Commission and said report shall be transmitted to each Commissioner's office no less than 60 days prior to the implementation of any such transit fare or service adjustments.
