RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. R-830-23 AND APPROVING THE ISSUANCE BY ARIZONA INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, OF ITS REVENUE BONDS IN ONE OR MORE SERIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000,000.00 FOR THE BENEFIT OF TRUE NORTH CLASSICAL ACADEMY, INC. TO FUND A PLAN OF FINANCE WHICH INCLUDES CAPITAL PROJECTS LOCATED IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSES OF SECTION 147(F) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Arizona Industrial Development Authority (the “Authority”), a nonprofit corporation and political subdivision of the State of Arizona, is authorized to issue tax-exempt, taxable and tax credit conduit bonds for public and eligible private entities throughout all 50 states (the “Arizona Industrial Development Authority Bond Program”); and

WHEREAS, True North Classical Academy, Inc. (“Borrower”) is eligible to participate in the Arizona Industrial Development Authority Bond Program and the Authority has agreed, subject to certain terms and conditions, to issue up to \$30,000,000.00 of revenue bonds (the “Bonds”); and

WHEREAS, the Bonds are expected to be part of a larger issuance of bonds for the benefit of multiple charter schools in multiple states, whereby the proceeds of the larger issuance of bonds will be loaned to Equitable Facilities Fund, Inc., a Delaware nonstock corporation described in section 501(c)(3) of the Code (“EFF”), or Equitable School Revolving Fund, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company affiliate of EFF that is disregarded for federal tax purposes (together with EFF, the “Lender”), and the Lender will use proceeds of the Bonds to finance or refinance a loan to or for the benefit of the Borrower to finance and/or refinance the acquisition, construction,

expansion, remodeling, renovation, improvement, furnishing and/or equipping of the charter school educational facilities known as True North Classical Academy Sunset, located at 9393 Sunset Drive, Miami, FL 31173, True North Classical Academy at Gateway, located at 6500 SW 97th Ave., Miami, FL 33173 and True North Classical Academy at Dadeland, located at 7900 SW 86th Street, Miami, FL 33143 by refunding all of the outstanding Miami-Dade County Industrial Development Authority Industrial Development Revenue Bonds (True North Classical Academy, Inc. Project), (Series 2020A), and pay costs of the issuance of the Bonds, as more particularly described in the public hearing notice attached as Exhibit “A” (the “Public Hearing Notice”) to this resolution (the “Plan of Finance”); and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-830-23, adopted by the Board on October 3, 2023, approved the issuance of the Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$13,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority and the Borrower have requested that the Board conduct a new public hearing in order to approve the issuance of an increase of the not to exceed amount of the Bonds from \$13,000,000.00 to \$30,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to rescind Resolution No. R-830-23 and, after a public hearing following reasonable public notice pursuant to section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), approve the issuance of the Bonds to fund the Plan of Finance in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing Notice was published at least seven days in advance of a public hearing by this Board to consider the issuance of the Bonds pursuant to section 147(f) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing so noticed was duly held by the Board and as a result, the Board desires to approve the issuance of the Bonds for the purpose of complying with section 147(f) of the Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board ratifies and adopts the matters set forth in the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. Resolution No. R-830-23 is hereby rescinded and the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority on behalf of the Borrower in an aggregate principal amount not-to-exceed \$30,000,000.00 to fund the Plan of Finance is approved for the purposes of section 147(f) of the Code.

Section 3. The Bonds, related interest and any other obligations incurred in connection with the Bonds shall not constitute a general obligation, debt or indebtedness of the State of Florida (the “State”) or the County or any political subdivision of the State within the meaning of any provision of the Constitution and laws of the State and shall not constitute nor give rise to a pecuniary liability or a charge against the general credit or taxing powers of the State or the County, but shall be payable solely from the revenues and other moneys specifically provided by the Borrower for the payment of the Bonds, related interest and any other obligation incurred in connection with the Bonds.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Vice Chairman Anthony Rodríguez. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Anthony Rodriguez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

The Bonds are expected to be part of a larger issuance of bonds for the benefit of multiple charter schools in multiple states, all issued by the Issuer, whereby the proceeds of the larger issuance of bonds will be loaned to Equitable Facilities Fund, Inc., a Delaware nonstock corporation described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (“EFF”), or Equitable School Revolving Fund, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company affiliate of EFF that is disregarded for federal tax purposes (together with EFF, the “Lender”). The Lender will use proceeds of the Bonds to finance or refinance a loan to True North Classical Academy, Inc., duly organized and validly existing Florida nonprofit corporation described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (the “Borrower”). The Project, the owner of the Project, the initial occupant of the Project, the Borrower of the proceeds of the Bonds, and the location of the Project are further described below:

A. Owner: True North Classical Academy, Inc.

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C. Description of Project: The Project includes the acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, improvement, furnishing and/or equipping of charter school educational facilities known as (a) True North Classical Academy Sunset, located at 9393 Sunset Drive, Miami, FL 31173, in an amount not to exceed \$9,500,000 and (b) True North Classical Academy at Gateway, located at 6500 SW 97th Ave., Miami, FL 33173 in an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.

D. Project Location: 9393 Sunset Drive, Miami, FL 31173 and 6500 SW 97th Ave., Miami, FL 33173

E. Maximum amount of Bonds to be issued with respect to the Project: \$13,000,000.

The Bonds, including the principal of (premium, if any) and interest thereon, do not constitute a debt or a loan of credit or a pledge of the full faith and credit or taxing power of the Issuer, the Board, the County, the State of Florida, or any political subdivision thereof, within the meaning of any State Constitutional provision or statutory limitation and shall never constitute or give rise to a pecuniary liability of the Issuer, the Board, the County, the State of Florida, or any political subdivision thereof. The Bonds shall not constitute, directly or indirectly, or contingently

obligate or otherwise constitute a general obligation of or a charge against the general credit of the Issuer, the Board, the County, the State of Florida, or any political subdivision thereof, but shall be special limited obligations of the Issuer payable solely from the sources provided for in the proceedings for the issuance of the Bonds. The Issuer has no taxing power.
