Subject: Resolution Confirming County Maintenance of Improvements to be Constructed Within the Biscayne Trail Segment D along the South Florida Water Management District's C-103 Canal

Executive Summary

This item confirms the Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department's (PROS) maintenance of improvements to the Biscayne Trail, which will be constructed within the South Florida Water Management District's (the District) right-of-way. The improvements include a 12-foot-wide shared use asphalt trail, signage, and access control bollards. The estimated annual maintenance cost is \$35,000.00. This resolution satisfies a requirement of the District's permit-granting process.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board adopt the attached resolution confirming the County shall, through PROS, maintain improvements on the Biscayne Trail Segment D (Attachment A to this Memorandum), within the District's C-103 Canal right-of-way.

Scope

The Biscayne Trail Segment D is an asset of regional significance, located within the District's C-103 Canal right-of-way; therefore, the scope is countywide.

Fiscal Impact/Funding

The estimated annual cost of maintaining the constructed trail improvements is \$35,000.00, to be funded by the PROS General Fund Budget. The County's estimate of the total project cost is \$5,675,000.00, of which \$1,521,849.00 was awarded to PROS by the Florida SUN Trail grant program.

Track Record/Monitor

The PROS Right-of-Way Aesthetic & Assets Management Division's (RAAM) Chief will coordinate with the District to ensure the improvements are maintained to District and PROS standards.

Delegation of Authority

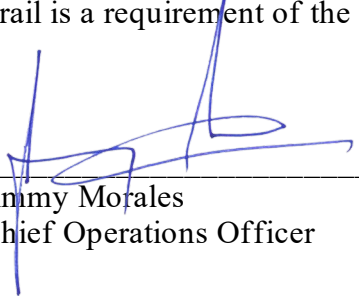
The County Mayor or County Mayor's Designee is authorized to take necessary actions for the maintenance of the improvements on the Biscayne Trail Segment D along the District's C-103 Canal.

Background

The Biscayne Trail is part of the South Dade Greenways Master Plan and the Open Space Master Plan that the County, through PROS, is committed to build, operate, and maintain. The Biscayne Trail

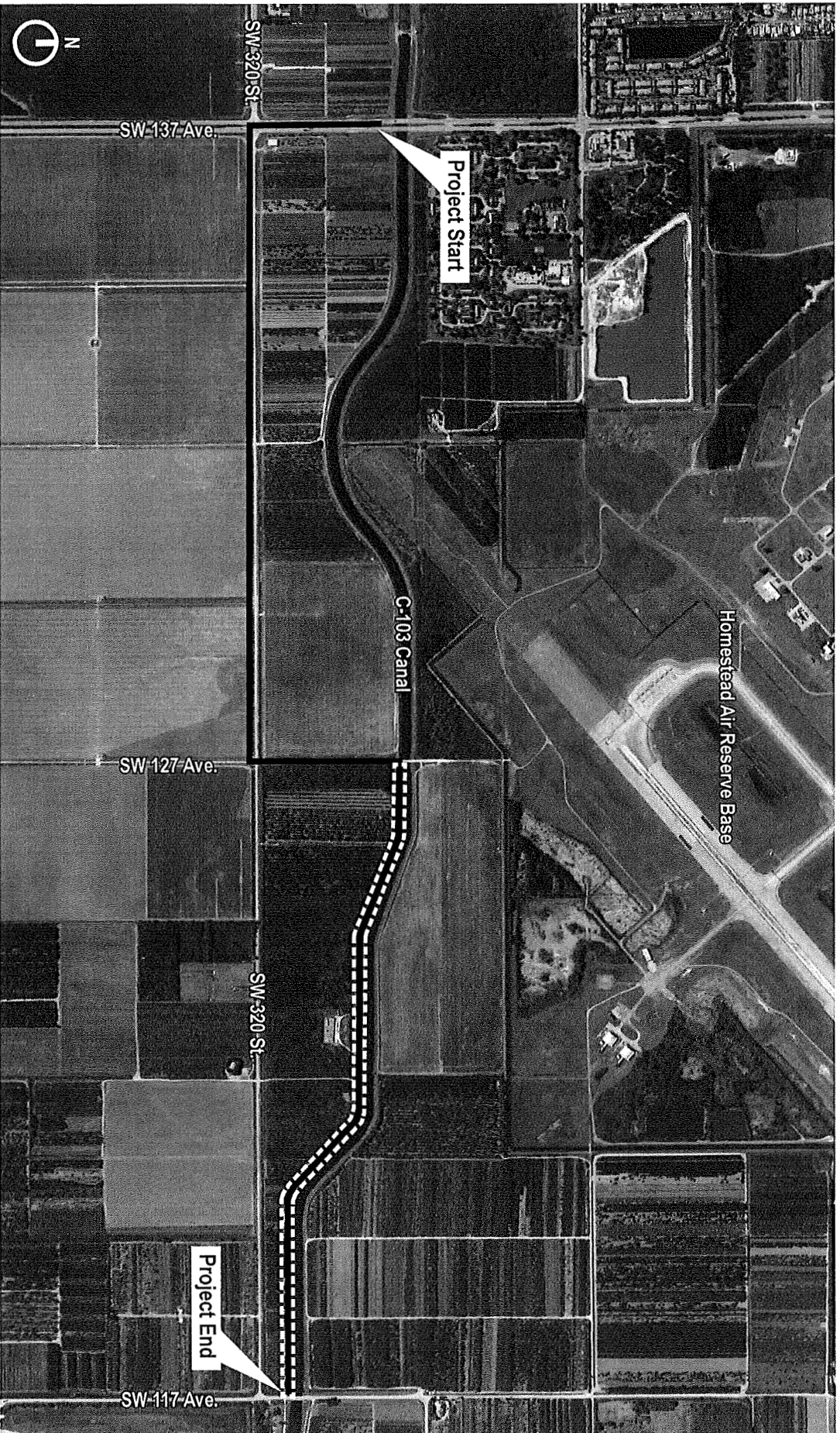
Segment D Phase 2 project is a 2.5-mile segment of the larger 43-mile Biscayne-Everglades Greenway that will connect Everglades National Park and Biscayne National Park via shared-use trails. The project will be built along South Florida Water Management District canals and County-operated roadways in southern Miami-Dade County, east of Homestead.

The County passed Resolution No. R-679-95 on May 16, 1995, adopting the South Dade Greenways Master Plan, of which the Biscayne Trail along the District's C-103 canal from SW 127 Avenue to SW 137 Avenue forms a part. PROS has Florida SUN Trail funding to construct improvements within the District's C-103 canal right of way. The District has required that the County affirm via resolution that the County shall perform maintenance on facilities that the County constructed or desires to construct on District properties. The County, through PROS, secures right of way occupancy permits to build, operate, and maintain trails and associated improvements within the District's rights of way. This confirmation by resolution of the County's maintenance of the improvements to the Biscayne Trail is a requirement of the District to obtain a right of way occupancy permit.

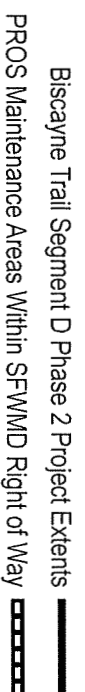

Placement of this item on the requested Board agenda is critical for the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department to ensure receipt of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) funding for the Biscayne Trail Segment D project. FDOT recently notified PROS that this was required prior to a specific date and that PROS could potentially lose a total of \$4.1 million in grant funding for the SUNTrail - Biscayne Trail Segment D Phase 2 Construction project. Therefore, I am respectfully requesting that this item be placed on the the April 16, 2024 Board of County Commissioners meeting agenda.
