COUNTY'S STATE LOBBYISTS TO ADVOCATE IN
SUPPORT OF BOTH BILLS DURING THE 2024 SESSION OF
THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, at the January 17, 2024 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made by Senator René Garcia supporting the enactment of Senate Bill ("SB") 198 and House Bill ("HB") 245, and directing the County's state lobbyists to advocate in support of both bills,
