Subject: Resolution Approving the Waiver of Plat of Laisy Martinez and Teresita S. Martinez filed by Laisy Martinez and Teresita S. Martinez

Recommendation

The following waiver of plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This waiver of plat for Laisy Martinez and Teresita S. Martinez is bounded on the north by SW 264 Street, on the east approximately 140 feet west of SW 171 Avenue, on the south approximately 410 feet north of SW 266 Terrace and on the west approximately 235 feet east of SW 172 Avenue.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this waiver of plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

Legal description of the boundaries of the land are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

Scope

This waiver of plat is located in Commission District 8, which is represented by Commissioner Danielle Cohen Higgins.

Delegation of Authority

There are no delegation requirements with this item.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County with the approval of this plat, as all improvements are in place.

Track Record/Monitor

The Development Services Division within the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P.L.S.

Background

Laisy Martinez and Teresita S. Martinez (D-24919)

- Located in Section 31, Township 56 South, Range 39 East.
- Zoning: EU-1C.
- Proposed usage: One single family residence.
- Number of parcels: One.
- This waiver of plat meets concurrency.
- This proposed single-family residence was determined to not be within feasible distance to public water or public sanitary sewer pursuant to the new feasible distance Ordinance No. 22-137.
- As a condition of this waiver of plat approval, the proposed single-family residence will be required to provide an on-site domestic well and an onsite sewage treatment and disposal system (OSTDS) for this site.
- The proposed single-family residence will be required to install a Type 3 OSTDS to comply the new OSTDS requirements adopted in Ordinance No. 22-83.

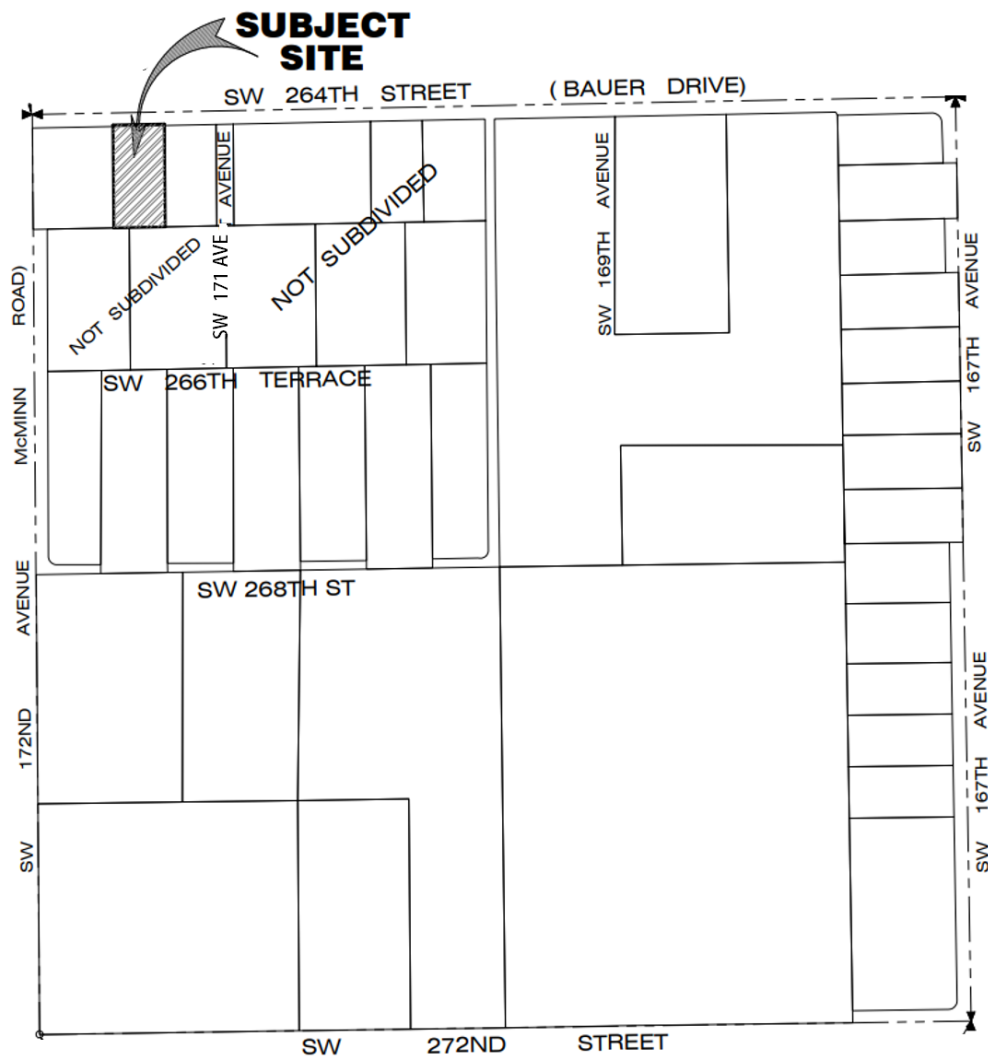

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WAIVER OF PLAT OF LAISY MARTINEZ AND TERESITA S. MARTINEZ, D-24919, FILED BY LAISY MARTINEZ AND TERESITA S. MARTINEZ, LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 56 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY SW 264 STREET, ON THE EAST APPROXIMATELY 140 FEET WEST OF SW 171 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 410 FEET NORTH OF SW 266 TERRACE AND ON THE WEST APPROXIMATELY 235 FEET EAST OF SW 172 AVENUE)

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Laisy Martinez and Teresita S. Martinez, husband and wife, have this day presented to this Board a waiver of plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said waiver of plat of the property legally described as a portion of land lying and being in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 31, Township 56 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said waiver of plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said waiver of plat is hereby approved; that the property has been found to be in compliance with chapter 28, Subdivisions, of the Miami-Dade County Code; that approval of this waiver of plat is not a waiver

of any zoning regulations; and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this waiver of plat conforms to those requirements.
