RESOLUTION NO. R-415-24

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO REPLACE TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES INSTALLED IN THE HIGHLAND LAKES NEIGHBORHOOD WITHIN DISTRICT 4 WITH PERMANENT ASPHALT SPEEDHUMPS AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS

WHEREAS, after analyzing data on cut through traffic, the Miami-Dade County Transportation and Public Works Department ("DTPW") installed a pilot project in the Highland Lakes neighborhood beginning in April 2019 that included speedhumps as temporary traffic calming devices; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to replace the temporary installation with permanent asphalt speedhumps at 20 locations, specifically:

WHEREAS, DTPW included funding in the 2023-2024 County Budget for the replacement of the temporary speedhumps in the amount of \$460,000.00 under Project Number CND000003008225; and

WHEREAS, DTPW projects the project will take one year to complete, with installation between June of 2024 and June of 2025,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals to this resolution are incorporated herein and are approved.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or County's Mayor's designee to install permanent asphalt speedhumps at the following locations utilizing the funding established for Project No. CND000003008225 and to identify legally available funding for any additional project costs:
