RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-301-24

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF WEST 56TH
STREET FROM PALM AVENUE TO WEST 2ND AVENUE AS
"LOURDES LOZANO STREET"

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah passed Resolution No. 2023-219 on January 8, 2024, which codesignated that portion of West 56th Street from Palm Avenue to West 2nd Avenue as "Lourdes Lozano Street" in memory of Lourdes Lozano ("Lozano"), a former Hialeah Council Member who dedicated herself to the Hialeah community; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. 2023-219 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Lozano was appointed to the Hialeah Housing Authority as a Commissioner in 2009; and

WHEREAS, from 2011 to 2019, Lozano served as a Hialeah Council Member; and

WHEREAS, throughout her lifetime, Lozano volunteered for organizations in the Hialeah community; and

WHEREAS, Lozano passed away on February 22, 2020; and

WHEREAS, that portion of West 56th Street from Palm Avenue to West 2nd Avenue is a city road located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is in County Commission District 13; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah would like for the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Lozano by approving the City of Hialeah’s codesignation of that portion of West 56th Street from Palm Avenue to West 2nd Avenue as “Lourdes Lozano Street,”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Hialeah’s codesignation of that portion of West 56th Street from Palm Avenue to West 2nd Avenue as “Lourdes Lozano Street.”

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Mayor and Commission of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resource Department, the Hialeah Police Department, and the Hialeah Fire Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García. It was offered by Commissioner **Sen. René García** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-219

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, NAMING WEST 56TH STREET FROM PALM AVENUE TO WEST 2ND AVENUE AS "LOURDES LOZANO STREET", WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the street naming of West 56th Street from Palm Avenue to West 2nd Avenue, Hialeah, Florida as "Lourdes Lozano Street" is in honor of Lourdes Lozano who served as a Hialeah Council Member from November 18, 2011 through November 8, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2009, Lourdes Lozano was appointed to the Hialeah Housing Authority as a Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Lozano worked for the Florida Department of Children and Families as a Community Liaison; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Lozano was involved in volunteer organizations in Hialeah over her lifetime; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Lozano passed away on February 22, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Lourdes Lozano was a public servant who worked tirelessly for the welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, that portion of West 56 Street between West 2nd Avenue and Palm Avenue is a road located in the City of Hialeah and is classified as a City or municipal street with the State Road System; and

WHEREAS, this proposed street naming is located in Miami-Dade County Commission District 13; and

WHEREAS, at its November 28, 2023 meeting, the City of Hialeah Historic Preservation Board passed and adopted Resolution No. 2023-007 recommending the street naming to the City Council; and,

WHEREAS, among the duties of the City's Historic Preservation Board is to recommend to the City Council the naming of city-owned buildings or areas within buildings, facilities, parks, rights-of-way, and other city properties within municipal limits;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

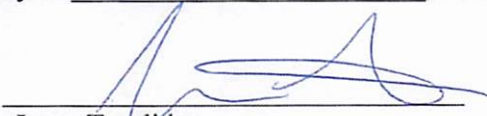
Section 2: The City Council hereby re-names West 56th Street from Palm Avenue to West 2nd Avenue, Hialeah, Florida to "Lourdes Lozano Street", with the cost of signage to be paid by the City, in her honor, as a former City of Hialeah Council Member and public servant.

Section 3: The Mayor and City Council direct the City Clerk to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Mayor of Miami-Dade County, the Miami-Dade County Public Works Director, and the Clerk to the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective when approved by a majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.

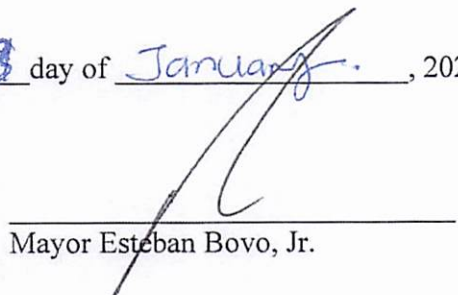

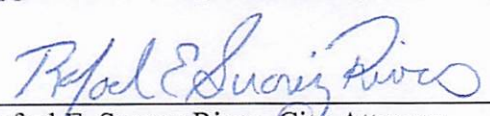
