RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HIALEAH'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF EAST 51ST
STREET FROM 6TH AVENUE TO EAST 7TH AVENUE AS
"ROGELIO VELOZ WAY"

WHEREAS, Rogelio Veloz is a City of Hialeah resident since 1981; and

WHEREAS, Rogelio Veloz is a contractor and produces work throughout the City of
Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, in honor of Veloz, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, on
April 23, 2024, passed Resolution R-2024-115, which approved the City's codesignation of East
51st Street from 6th Avenue to East 7th Avenue in Hialeah, Florida as "Rogelio Veloz Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of East 51st Street between 6th Avenue and East 7th Avenue is a
City-maintained road located in the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution R-2024-115 is attached hereto and incorporated by
reference; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah would like the County to install signage indicating this
codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Veloz by approving the City of Hialeah's
codesignation of that portion of East 51st Street between 6th Avenue and East 7th Avenue as
"Rogelio Veloz Way"; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 13,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Hialeah’s codesignation of that portion of East 51st Street between 6th Avenue and East 7th Avenue as “Rogelio Veloz Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Hialeah Police Department, and the City of Hialeah Fire Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García. It was offered by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Raquel A. Regalado** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-115

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-053 APPROVED AND ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 13, 2024, RE-NAMING EAST 51ST STREET FROM 6TH AVENUE TO EAST 7TH AVENUE AS "ROGELIO VELOZ WAY", WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the street re-naming East 51st Street from 6th Avenue to East 7th Avenue, Hialeah, Florida as "Rogelio Veloz Way" is in honor of Rogelio Veloz; and

WHEREAS, Rogelio Veloz is a City of Hialeah resident since 1981; and

WHEREAS, Rogelio Veloz is a contractor and produces work throughout the City of Hialeah; and

WHEREAS, that portion of East 51st Street from 6th Avenue to East 7th Avenue is a road located in the City of Hialeah and is classified as a City or municipal street with the State Road System; and

WHEREAS, this proposed street naming is located in Miami-Dade County Commission District 13; and

WHEREAS, at its January 22, 2024 meeting, the City of Hialeah Historic Preservation Board passed and adopted Resolution No. 2024-001 recommending this street re-naming; and

WHEREAS, among the duties of the City's Historic Preservation Board is to recommend to the City Council the naming of city-owned buildings or areas within buildings, facilities, parks, rights-of-way, and other city properties within municipal limits.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

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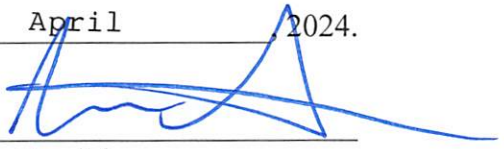
Section 2. Resolution No. 2024-053 adopted on February 13, 2024 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

Section 3. The City Council hereby designates East 51st Street from 6th Avenue to East 7th Avenue as “Rogelio Veloz Way”, with the cost of signage to be paid by the City, in recognition of Rogelio Veloz.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Resolution to the Mayor of Miami-Dade County, the County Commissioner for District 13, and the Clerk of the Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida, or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.

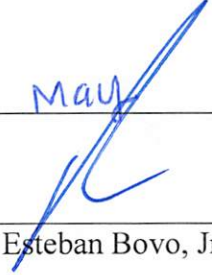
