EACH NOVEMBER 13 THEREAFTER, AS WORLD KINDNESS
DAY IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, World Kindness Day is celebrated internationally on November 13; and

WHEREAS, since its launch in 1998, World Kindness Day has been observed by numerous organizations across the globe that encourage individuals to practice kindness and perform good deeds within their communities; and

WHEREAS, the celebration of World Kindness Day promotes compassion, generosity, and empathy; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to promote the above values and celebrate the good deeds of Miami-Dade County residents; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to further encourage kindness throughout Miami-Dade County by declaring November 13, 2024, and each November 13 thereafter, as World Kindness Day,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby declares November 13, 2024, and the day of November 13 each year thereafter, as World Kindness Day in Miami-Dade County.
