Subject: Resolution Retroactively Approving the Submittal of a Grant Application to the Florida Department of Transportation for up to \$1,000,000.00 for 2023 Transportation Alternative, Biscayne Trail Segment D Phase 1 Construction

Executive Summary

The item retroactively approves the Miami-Dade Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department's (PROS) submission of a grant application to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 for funding to support the construction of a 2.5-mile segment of the Biscayne Trail, beginning at the west side of SW 117 Avenue and heading east along the south bank of the C-103 Canal, then turning south and following the L-103 Canal to SW 328 Street at Homestead Bayfront Park.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board retroactively approve the grant application for Florida Department of Transportation 2023 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program funds totaling \$1,000,000.00 for Biscayne Trail Segment D Phase 1 Construction. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to receive and expend funds and execute grant agreements upon review and final approval of the County Attorney's Office.

Scope

Construction of the 2.5-mile segment of the Biscayne Trail is within County Commission District 9, which is represented by Commissioner Kionne L. McGhee.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The County's estimate for the Biscayne Trail Segment D Phase 1 Construction project is \$1,862,086.00. If awarded, FDOT will provide funds up to \$1,000,000.00. Match funding in the amount of \$862,086.00 will come from FY 2022-23 Miami-Dade County Adopted Budget and Multi-year Capital Plan, as Park Impact Fees for Local Park Development-Park Benefit District (PBD) No. 3.

Track Record/Monitor

PROS has been awarded \$16,646,891.00 in funds through FDOT Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside in the past nine years. The proposed grant will be administered by PROS Grants Supervisor Dorothy Mills-Mayers.

Delegation of Authority

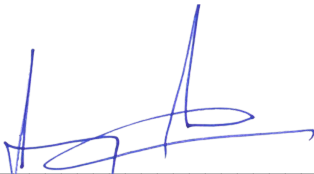
This item authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute grant award agreements, amendments and other documents the grant requires, following approval by the County Attorney's Office as to legal sufficiency; provided however that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee are only delegated the authority to execute amendments that do not have an additional fiscal impact on the County

and that otherwise are for projects eligible under the Florida Department of Transportation. The Board authorizes the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Background

This segment of trail will connect to a portion of trail currently in the design phase east of SW 117 Avenue, as well as segments of trail recently completed by the City of Homestead. The trail will be a 12-foot-wide asphalt multiuse path with regulatory and wayfinding signage, intersection and trail pavement markings, removable bollards to control trail access, and three bike racks at the trail terminus.

FDOT Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside is intended to fund a variety of small-scale transportation projects such as pedestrian and bicycle facilities, recreational trails, safe routes to school projects, community improvements such as historic preservation and vegetation management, and environmental mitigation related to stormwater and habitat connectivity. FDOT requires infrastructure projects be implemented by a Local Agency Program (LAP) certified agency, Miami-Dade County maintains this certification through its Department of Transportation and Public Works. The application was due February 20, 2023, and was submitted February 16, 2023. There was insufficient time from the opportunity announcement to the grant deadline to obtain a resolution, and an adopted resolution was not required by the funding agency for the application submittal. If awarded, the prioritized project will be programmed into the FDOT 5-Year Work Program and PROS will work with FDOT to execute the funding agreement timely.

RESOLUTION NO. R-731-24

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE PROGRAM FOR \$1,000,000.00 SUPPORTING CONSTRUCTION OF A 2.5-MILE SEGMENT OF THE BISCAYNE TRAIL, BEGINNING AT THE WEST SIDE OF SW 117 AVENUE AND HEADING EAST ALONG THE SOUTH BANK OF THE C-103 CANAL, THEN TURNING SOUTH AND FOLLOWING THE L-103 CANAL TO SW 328 STREET AT HOMESTEAD BAYFRONT PARK; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND FUNDS AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS, AMENDMENTS, AND OTHER DOCUMENTS AS REQUIRED BY THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board retroactively approves the submission of an application to the Florida Department of Transportation alternatives set-aside program for funds up to \$1,000,000.00. The County will provide up to \$862,086.00 in matching funds from Park Impact Fees, as authorized within the Department's Multi-year Capital Plan program titled Local Park Development-Park Benefit District (PBD) No. 3.

Section 2. The Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to accept and expend funds and execute contracts, amendments, and other documents as required by the grant, upon review and final approval of the County Attorney's Office. A copy of the Florida Department of Transportation grant application is on file with the Parks, Recreation and Open

Spaces Department and available for inspection upon request. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall be required to seek Board approval for any approvals, consents, actions, events or undertakings that would create a financial obligation, cost or expense to the County beyond those specifically identified and set forth in the Agreement.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Raquel A. Regalado** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
