RESOLUTION DECLARING ONE 2016 FORD TAURUS AND ONE 2016 FORD FUSION SURPLUS; AUTHORIZING THEIR DONATION TO MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR USE IN THE MIAMI LAKES TECHNICAL COLLEGE AUTOMOTIVE TECHNICIAN PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE FOREGOING

WHEREAS, the vehicles described below are owned by Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles are obsolete, their continued usage by Miami-Dade County is uneconomical and inefficient, and the vehicles serve no useful purpose; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Public Schools (the "Donee") is a governmental unit under section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County (the "Code") and operates the Miami Lakes Technical College Automotive Technician Program at Hialeah Senior High School; and

WHEREAS, the Donee desires to use the vehicles only in Miami-Dade County to enhance its ability to provide services to its constituents for the purposes outlined in the attached Surplus Property Application; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's Internal Services Department has complied with the requirements of section 2-11.2.1 of the Code by offering the vehicles to other Miami-Dade County departments and agencies, none of which accepted the vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles are eligible for donation under section 274.05 of the Florida Statutes and section 2-11.2.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board declares the following vehicles, with the listed residual value and other characteristics, to be surplus pursuant to section 274.05 of the Florida Statutes and section 2-11.2.1 of the Code:

Section 2. This Board authorizes donation of the vehicles to the Donee for use in Miami Lakes Technical College Automotive Technician Program at Hialeah Senior High School, as outlined in the attached Surplus Property Application. The Donee shall take possession of the vehicles within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution. The Donee shall be responsible for any and all costs of transferring the vehicles. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall and is hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution.

Section 3. If, for any reason, the Donee fails to take possession of the vehicles within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution, then this resolution shall be null and void, and the ownership rights to the vehicles shall remain with the County.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García. It was offered by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
