RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MIAMI FASHION WEEK IN
MIAMI-DADE COUNTY EACH YEAR

WHEREAS, Miami Fashion Week, also known as MIAFW, is a global event celebrating fashion innovation and drawing renowned designers, influencers, and industry leaders to Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Miami Fashion Week is comprised of runway shows, fashion presentations, events, panel discussions, workshops and designer popups; and

WHEREAS, Miami Fashion Week serves as a significant platform for the fashion industry, fostering creativity and providing opportunities for diverse designers to present their work to a global audience; and

WHEREAS, this past year, Miami Fashion Week occurred November 19 through November 23, 2024, attracting thousands of attendees and generating substantial economic impact for Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Miami Fashion Week highlights Miami-Dade County as a global hub for fashion and innovation, bridging cultures through art and design; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County's fashion industry is an important contributor to the local economy, supporting hundreds of jobs in design, retail, event management, and tourism; and

WHEREAS, Miami Fashion Week has partnered with organizations such as the Greater Miami Convention and Visitors Bureau to amplify the reach of its event, which enhances Miami-Dade County's reputation as a world-class destination for fashion, arts, and culture; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes the significance of Miami Fashion Week in fostering creativity, cultural exchange, and economic growth in Miami-Dade County and wishes to celebrate its annual contributions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby recognizes Miami Fashion Week on the fourth week of October in 2025 and each year thereafter.
