RESOLUTION DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY
MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO REJECT
AND READVERTISE ALL BIDS, WITHOUT FURTHER
ACTION FROM THE BOARD, FOR CONSTRUCTION
PROJECTS WHERE BIDS CAN NO LONGER BE AWARDED
DUE TO ANY LIMITATIONS OR PREEMPTIONS ARISING
UNDER HOUSE BILL 705

WHEREAS, at the January 22, 2025 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made to delegate authority to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to reject and readvertise all bids, without further approval action from the Board, for construction projects where bids can no longer be awarded due to any limitations or preemptions arising under House Bill (HB) 705,
