RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO
APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR THE TRIANGLE PARK AND
CHILDREN’S ACADEMY PEDESTRIAN SAFETY INITIATIVE
AS WELL AS THE CITRUS GROVE SCHOOL CHILDREN AND
FAMILIES PEDESTRIAN SAFETY INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, at the February 4, 2025 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made: (1) urging the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding for the Triangle Park and Children’s Academy Pedestrian Safety Initiative as well as the Citrus Grove School Children and Families Pedestrian Safety Initiative; (2) directing the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of the resolution memorializing this motion to the Governor, the Senate President, the House Speaker, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation; (3) directing the County’s state lobbyists to advocate for the foregoing; and (4) directing the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to: (a) amend the 2025 State Legislative Package to include this item, and (b) include this item in the 2026 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding for the Triangle Park and Children’s Academy Pedestrian Safety Initiative as well as the Citrus Grove School Children and Families Pedestrian Safety Initiative.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, the Senate President, the House Speaker, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County’s state lobbyists to advocate for the action described in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to: (a) amend the 2025 State Legislative Package to include this item, and (b) include this item in the 2026 State Legislative Package when it is presented to the Board.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Eileen Higgins. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
