RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF S.W.
152ND AVENUE FROM S.W. 63RD TERRACE TO S.W. 69TH
STREET AS "AVENIDA COLOMBIA"

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is home to a large population of Colombian origin, making it one of the most significant hubs for the Colombian diaspora in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Colombian community has played a significant role in shaping the cultural landscape of Miami-Dade County through its rich traditions in art, music, dance, and cuisine; and

WHEREAS, Colombians and Colombian-Americans in Miami-Dade County have enriched the community through their participation and leadership in education, healthcare, and public service, their entrepreneurial spirit in the establishment of several small businesses, and their exemplifying a commitment to service and excellence; and

WHEREAS, that portion of S.W. 152nd Avenue from S.W. 63rd Terrace to S.W. 69th Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 11; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners seeks to recognize the contributions of the Colombian community in Miami-Dade through this codesignation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Incorporates and adopts the foregoing whereas clauses as part of this resolution.

Section 2. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of S.W. 152nd Avenue from S.W. 63rd Terrace to S.W. 69th Street as “Avenida Colombia”.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resource Department, the Miami-Dade Sheriff’s Office, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Roberto J. Gonzalez. It was offered by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
