RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-333-25

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF NORTHWEST
15TH STREET BETWEEN NORTHWEST 33RD AVENUE AND
NORTHWEST 37TH AVENUE AS "REV. GUILLERMO A.
REVUELTA WAY"

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2025, the City of Miami (the "City") adopted Resolution No. R-25-0024, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, codesignating that portion of Northwest 15th Street between Northwest 33rd Avenue and Northwest 37th Avenue as "Rev. Guillermo A. Revuelta Way"; and

WHEREAS, as referenced in the City Resolution, Reverend Guillermo A. Revuelta ("Reverend Revuelta") has made significant contributions to the City and Miami-Dade County (the "County") through his dedicated service and leadership; and

WHEREAS, the City Resolution highlights Reverend Revuelta's decades of service in leadership roles for social and community service organizations including the National Association of Latin Elected and Appointed Officials ("NALEO"), the Spanish American League Against Discrimination ("SALAD"), and the League of United Latin American Citizens of Florida ("LULAC"), where he served as Vice President and Chaplain; and

WHEREAS, the City Resolution further emphasizes Reverend Revuelta's advocacy work for the community through his involvement in organizations like Fair Property Tax for All, the Cuban American Support and Aid Foundation ("CASAF"), and the Evangelical Association of Pastors; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Revuelta’s commitment to civic engagement is evident in the numerous boards and committees where he has served, including the City’s Planning Advisory Board (2003–2011), the City’s Nuisance Abatement Board (1994–2003), the City’s Community Relations Board, the County’s Community Relations Board, and the County’s Public School General Obligation Bond Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Revuelta has been instrumental in organizing community events, such as food drives, health fairs, and educational workshops, which have provided essential services and support to underserved populations; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Revuelta has mentored countless young leaders, fostering a spirit of civic engagement and social responsibility among the next generation; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Revuelta’s efforts have led to the establishment of various community programs aimed at improving the quality of life for residents, including initiatives focused on affordable housing, youth development, and senior services; and

WHEREAS, as referenced in the City Resolution, Reverend Revuelta has been a cornerstone in the community, earning him the President’s Volunteer Service Award in 2024; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Reverend Revuelta by approving the City’s codesignation of that portion of Northwest 15th Street between Northwest 33rd Avenue and Northwest 37th Avenue as “Rev. Guillermo A. Revuelta Way”; and

WHEREAS, the City would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Northwest 15th Street between Northwest 33rd Avenue and Northwest 37th Avenue is a city-maintained street located in the City; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami’s codesignation of that portion of Northwest 15th Street between Northwest 33rd Avenue and Northwest 37th Avenue as “Rev. Guillermo A. Revuelta Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami Police Department, and the City of Miami Department of Fire-Rescue.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Kevin Marino Cabrera. It was offered by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Roberto J. Gonzalez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
