**Subject:** Resolution Approving the Plat of Jinama South Subdivision Filed by Forestar (USA)  
Real Estate Group, Inc.

**Recommendation**

The following plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This plat for Jinama South Subdivision is bounded on the north approximately 1,000 feet south of SW 344 Street, on the east by SW 189 Avenue, on the south by SW 352 Street, and on the west by SW 192 Avenue.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

Full scale copy of the plat and legal description of the boundaries of the land being subdivided, as well as the plat restrictions contained therein, are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

**Scope**

This plat is located in Commission District 9, which is represented by Commissioner Kionne L. McGhee.

**Delegation of Authority**

There are no delegation requirements with this item.

**Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

If this plat is approved, the fiscal impact to the county would be approximately \$11,500.00 annually for the maintenance of new roadway construction adjacent to and within the project. These costs would be covered by the Department of Transportation and Public Works' annual General Fund allocation.

**Track Record/Monitor**

The Development Services Division within the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P.L.S.

**Background**

Jinama South Subdivision T-24581

- Located in Section 26, Township 57 South, Range 38 East.
- Zoning: PAD.
- Proposed Usage: 104 single family residences and 196 townhomes.
- Number of Parcels: 300.
- This plat meets concurrency.
- This residential development (single-family residences and townhomes) was determined to be within feasible distance to public water and public sanitary sewers using the feasible distance requirements in effect prior to the new feasible distance Ordinance No. 22-137. As a condition of this approval, the proposed development is required to connect to public water and public sanitary sewers.

**Developer's Obligation**

Paving, drainage, sidewalks, curb & gutter, valley gutter, curb, street name signs, traffic control signs, paving markings, detectable warning surfaces, and monumentation which are bonded under bond number 8401 in the amount of \$3,890,994.00.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF JINAMA SOUTH SUBDIVISION FILED BY FORESTAR (USA) REAL ESTATE GROUP, INC., LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 57 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH APPROXIMATELY 1,000 FEET SOUTH OF SW 344 STREET, ON THE EAST BY 189 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY SW 352 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY SW 192 AVENUE)

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

**WHEREAS**, Forestart (USA) real Estate Group, Inc., a Delaware Corporation, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as “Jinama South Subdivision,” the same being a subdivision of a portion of land lying and being in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 57 South, Range 38 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations; and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform to those requirements.
