RESOLUTION NO. _____ R-422-25

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF NW
24TH AVENUE BETWEEN NW 133RD STREET AND NW
135TH STREET AS “REV. DR. ANTWANE LENOIR, SR.
AVENUE”

WHEREAS, Rev. Dr. Antwane Lenoir, Sr. (“Rev. Dr. Lenoir”), the Pastor of Westview Baptist Church and the Chaplain for the North Miami Police Department, passed away on April 6, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Dr. Lenoir was raised in Miami-Dade County and was deeply rooted in his community, having completed the Mortuary Science Curriculum at Miami-Dade College and earned a Bachelor of Arts in Business and Public Administration from Barry University; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Dr. Lenoir was a devoted husband and father, and was known for his unwavering commitment to both his family and his congregation; and

WHEREAS, he was widely respected across the state by fellow pastors and faith leaders, who praised his compassion, warmth, and dedication to community engagement; and

WHEREAS, affectionately known as “Pastor A.D.,” Rev. Dr. Lenoir led Westview Baptist Church with a mission to serve and uplift others, once stating, “We want to reach our community and invest whatever resources we have into them,” and “We are trying to model Christ in a practical way”; and

WHEREAS, he is survived by his beloved wife Bree and their four children, and will be remembered as a man who built meaningful relationships, lived faith boldly, and made a lasting impact on all who knew him; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Rev. Dr. Lenoir and his contributions to the community by codesignating that portion of NW 24th Avenue between NW 133rd Street and NW 135th Street as “Rev. Dr. Antwane Lenoir, Sr. Avenue”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 24th Avenue between NW 133rd Street and NW 135th Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 2,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of NW 24th Avenue between NW 133rd Street and NW 135th Street as “Rev. Dr. Antwane Lenoir, Sr. Avenue”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Sheriff’s Office, and the Miami-Dade County Fire-Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Marleine Bastien. It was offered by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Raquel A. Regalado** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
