RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO INCLUDE IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 COUNTY BUDGET SUFFICIENT FUNDING AND STAFF TO IMPLEMENT THE SAME SYSTEMS AND PLATFORMS FOR THE DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PERMITTING AS THOSE THAT ARE AVAILABLE FOR BUILDING PERMITTING

WHEREAS, at the May 6, 2025 Board of County Commissioners' meeting, a motion was made directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to include in her proposed County budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 sufficient funding and staff to both the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department and the Information Technology Department, or successor departments, to allow for the implementation of the same systems and platforms for the County's division of environmental resource management (DERM) permitting as those that are available for building permitting, as this would benefit the development community by providing more transparency to the permitting and approval process for DERM,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to include in her proposed County budget for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 sufficient funding and staff to both the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department and the Information Technology Department, or successor departments, to allow for the implementation of the same systems and platforms for the DERM permitting as those that are available for building permitting.
