RESOLUTION WAIVING PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION NO. R-764-13 PROVIDING FOR THE BOARD'S SELECTION OF NO MORE THAN TEN PRIORITIES FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE MIAMI-DADE LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION; WAIVING PROVISIONS OF RESOLUTION NO. R-1267-18 DIRECTING THE OFFICE OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS TO SEEK THE INPUT OF THE COUNTY'S FEDERAL CONTRACT LOBBYISTS PRIOR TO THE BOARD'S SELECTION OF FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES; AND ACCEPTING AS FINAL THE 2025 FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AT ITS APRIL 1, 2025 MEETING

WHEREAS, at the May 6, 2025 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made relating to the 2025 federal legislative package to: (1) waive the provisions of Resolution No. R-764-13 providing for the Board's selection of no more than ten priorities for distribution to the Miami-Dade Legislative Delegation, (2) waive the provisions of Resolution No. R-1267-18 directing the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to seek the input of the County's federal contract lobbyists after the Board approves the federal legislative package and to prepare a report for the Board's consideration detailing the findings of said feedback prior to the Board's selection of the federal legislative priorities, and (3) accept as final the 2025 federal legislative package approved by the Board at its April 1, 2025 meeting,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board: (1) waives the provisions of Resolution No. R-764-13 providing for the Board's selection of no more than ten priorities for distribution to the Miami-Dade Legislative Delegation; (2) waives the provisions of Resolution No. R-1267-18 directing the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to seek the input of the County's federal contract lobbyists after the Board approves the federal legislative package

and to prepare a report for the Board’s consideration detailing the findings of said feedback prior to the Board’s selection of the federal legislative priorities; and (3) accepts as final the 2025 federal legislative package approved by the Board at its April 1, 2025 meeting.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Anthony Rodriguez. It was offered by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Natalie Milian Orbis** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

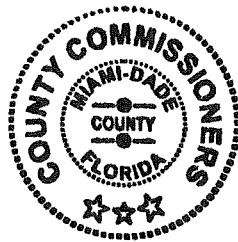
