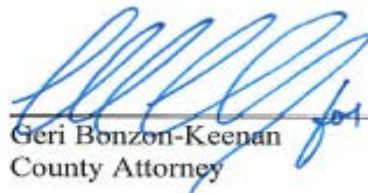

RESOLUTION NO. R-782-25

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDING FOR THE GLEN COVE ROADWAY RESURFACING AND RESTORATION PROJECT; URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS AND THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR THE GLEN COVE ROADWAY RESURFACING AND RESTORATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, maintaining adequate roadways and improving County infrastructure are critical priorities of this Board; and

WHEREAS, the Glen Cove Roadway Resurfacing and Restoration project (the "Project") aims to resurface and restore 1.5 miles of local roadways spanning Southwest 96th Terrace to Southwest 104th Street, from Southwest 114th Court to Southwest 117th Avenue in the Glen Cove community; and

WHEREAS, this corridor serves as a key connector for families, local schools, emergency responders, small businesses, and pedestrians in the Glen Cove area; and

WHEREAS, the Project will address significant infrastructure needs in the area by improving the roadway surface, ensuring safer travel conditions, and enhancing long-term durability of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Project is eligible for federal funding under 23 U.S. Code § 133(b), and will be administered by the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Project supports the goals of the 2021 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law by promoting safer streets, improving infrastructure resiliency, and ensuring equitable access to transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the federal government provide assistance for this essential public works project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's Designee to apply for federal funding for the Glen Cove Roadway Resurfacing and Restoration project.

Section 2. Urges the United States Congress and the United States Department of Transportation to appropriate funding for the Glen Cove Roadway Resurfacing and Restoration project.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to United States Secretary of Transportation Sean P. Duffy, United States House Speaker Mike Johnson, Senate Majority Leader John R. Thune, and the Chair and Members of the Florida Congressional Delegation.

Section 4. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the action described in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2025 Federal Legislative Package to include this item.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Danielle Cohen Higgins** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
