**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO OPEN A LIBRARY
WITHIN THE BRICKELL AREA WITHIN 24 MONTHS**

WHEREAS, at the June 3, 2025 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made based upon the report provided to the Board at the same meeting regarding possible locations for a library in the Brickell area, to direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to: (1) open a library within the Brickell area within 24 months; (2) identify legally available funds in the FY 2026-2027 budget for such purpose; (3) provide quarterly written updates on the status of such directives to the Commissioner of District 5; and (4) take all actions necessary to effectuate the purposes of the motion, provided that any County contracts or leases shall be subject to the Board's prior approval,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to: (1) open a library within the Brickell area within 24 months from June 3, 2025; (2) identify legally available funds in the FY 2026-2027 budget for such purpose; (3) provide quarterly written updates on the status of such directives to the Commissioner of District 5; and (4) take all actions necessary to effectuate the purposes of this resolution, provided that any County contracts or leases shall be subject to this Board's prior approval.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Eileen Higgins. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Kionne L. McGhee** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
