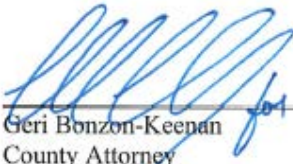

RESOLUTION NO. R-447-25

**RESOLUTION MAKING APPOINTMENT TO FILL THE
VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER
FOR DISTRICT 6**

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2025, Commissioner Kevin Marino Cabrera irrevocably resigned as Miami-Dade County Commissioner for District 6, effective immediately; and

WHEREAS, the Office of County Commissioner for District 6 became vacant on April 14, 2025; and

WHEREAS, section 1.07 of the Home Rule Charter requires that vacancies in the office of County Commissioner “shall be filled by majority vote of the remaining members of the Board within 30 days, or the Board shall call an election to be held not more than 90 days thereafter to fill the vacancy”; and

WHEREAS, section 1.07 of the Home Rule Charter further provides that a “person appointed shall serve only until the next county-wide election”; and

WHEREAS, section 3.01 of the Home Rule Charter also provides that “[t]he election of the Commissioners from even-numbered districts shall be held in 1994 and every four years thereafter ... at the time of the state primary elections”; and

WHEREAS, the next county-wide election is currently the State Primary Election to be held in August 2026, which is already the election for the next term of the Office of County Commissioner for District 6; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to fill the vacancy in Miami-Dade County Commissioner, District 6 by appointment until the next county-wide election,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Natalie Milian Orbis is hereby appointed to serve as Miami-Dade County Commissioner, District 6 until the next county-wide election.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Anthony Rodriguez. It was offered by Commissioner **Oliver G. Gilbert, III**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Roberto J. Gonzalez** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
