RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-158-24 TO DECREASE THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS FOR IN-GAME AND EVENT-RELATED IN-KIND SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY MIAMI-DADE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 FOR THE 2026 COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME FROM \$1,000,000.00 TO \$100,000.00; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO WORK WITH THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO FACILITATE AN ALLOCATION OF \$900,000.00 OF LEGALLY AVAILABLE FUNDS FOR THE PROVISION OF IN-GAME AND EVENT-RELATED IN-KIND SERVICES FOR THE 2026 COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYOFF NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME SO THAT SUCH ALLOCATION IS REFLECTED IN THE SHERIFF'S FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET

WHEREAS, at the June 26, 2025 Board of County Commissioners' meeting, a motion was made (i) to amend Resolution No. R-158-24 to decrease the amount of funds for in-game and event-related in-kind services to be provided by Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department for fiscal year 2025-26 for the 2026 College Football Playoff National Championship Game from \$1,000,000.00 to \$100,000.00, and (ii) to direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to work with the Sheriff's Office to facilitate an allocation of \$900,000.00 of legally available funds for the provision of in-game and event-related in-kind services for the 2026 College Football Playoff National Championship Game so that such allocation is reflected in the Sheriff's fiscal year 2025-26 budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board amends Resolution No. R-158-24 to decrease the amount of funds for in-game and event-related in-kind services to be provided by Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department for fiscal year 2025-26 for the 2026 College Football Playoff National Championship Game from \$1,000,000.00 to \$100,000.00, and directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to work with the Sheriff's Office to facilitate an allocation of \$900,000.00 of legally available funds for the provision of in-game and event-related in-kind services for the 2026 College Football Playoff National Championship Game so that such allocation is reflected in the Sheriff's fiscal year 2025-26 budget.
