**RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ACCESS STATE
CONTRACTS FOR PROVISION OF SPECIAL NEEDS
HURRICANE SHELTER SERVICES**

WHEREAS, at the June 3, 2025 Board of County Commissioners meeting, a motion was made to direct the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to access any existing state contracts for provision of hurricane shelter services for special needs populations and award a contract for such services, without need for further action of this Board, subject to the availability of legally budgeted funds, unless such accessing jeopardizes potential future Federal reimbursement for such services, and in such case, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall place a report before the full Board of County Commissioners in 30 days,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to access any existing state contracts for provision of hurricane shelter services for special needs populations and award a contract for such services, without need for further action of this Board, subject to the availability of legally budgeted funds, unless such accessing jeopardizes potential future Federal reimbursement for such services, and in such case, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall place a report before the full Board of County Commissioners in 30 days.
