RESOLUTION NO. R-735-25

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R-313-25 TO CHANGE THE CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF NW 66TH STREET BETWEEN NW 18TH AVENUE AND THE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF MIAMI FROM BEING “TUNNEL VISION STREET” TO “CAN’T LIVE WITHOUT YOU STREET”

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2025, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-313-25, which among other things, codesignated that portion of NW 66th Street between NW 18th Avenue and the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Miami as “Tunnel Vision Street”; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to amend Resolution No. R-313-25 to change the codesignation of that portion of NW 66th Street between NW 18th Avenue and the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Miami from “Tunnel Vision Street” to “Can’t Live Without You Street”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 66th Street between 18th Avenue and the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Miami is a County maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County and County Commission District 3; and

WHEREAS, Rule 9.02 of the Board’s Rules of Procedure provides that resolutions regarding proposed naming, renaming or co-designation of Miami-Dade County roads, facilities or property shall be sponsored by the district commissioner where the road, facility or property is located and shall be considered at a public hearing,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, amends Resolution R-313-25 and changes the codesignation of that portion of NW 66th Street between 18th Avenue and the jurisdictional boundary of the City of Miami from “Tunnel Vision Street” to “Can’t Live Without You Street”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Sheriff’s Office, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Keon Hardemon. It was offered by Commissioner **Eileen Higgins** , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
