RESOLUTION NO. R-975-25

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR
COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO REVIEW AND COMPILE
A LIST OF EXISTING COUNTY BOARDS THAT HAVE
DUTIES OR FUNCTIONS RELATED TO HEALTHCARE, AND
TO PROVIDE A REPORT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") is the governing and ultimate policymaking body for Miami-Dade County (the "County"); and

WHEREAS, in order to assist the Board with its policymaking functions, this Board has created various County boards—as defined in section 2-11.36.1 of the Code of Miami-Dade County—to study issues of importance to this County and perform specific duties and responsibilities in furtherance of this Board's objectives; and

WHEREAS, some of those County boards act in an advisory capacity to provide information, guidance and advice to this Board on matters of importance to our community; and

WHEREAS, this Board has authority to establish health care policy for the County; and

WHEREAS, this Board has previously created County boards whose scope, duties or functions involve matters related to healthcare; and

WHEREAS, over the years, it has been a consistent goal of this Board to enhance the accessibility, efficiency, and quality of healthcare delivery and programs Countywide for all residents; and

WHEREAS, while the County has made progress in pursuit of these objectives, this Board remains committed to the goal of further enhancing health equity for all County residents, to ensure that individuals are able to attain their full health potential without being disadvantaged due to

their social position or other social determinants of health, such as income, education, food insecurity, geographic location, housing and living conditions, transportation, health literacy or lack of social support; and

WHEREAS, there may be opportunities for the County to further advance these objectives through the creation of new policies, programs and strategies related to the delivery of healthcare for all residents of Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, to that end, this Board wishes to understand the current landscape of existing County boards that have healthcare-related functions; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, this Board wishes to direct the administration to compile a list of existing County boards that have duties or functions related to healthcare, so that opportunities to enhance the County's efforts and fill any existing gaps may be analyzed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to review and compile a list of existing County boards, as that term is defined in section 2-11.36.1 of the Code, that have duties or functions related to healthcare, and to provide a written report to this Board within 60 days related to this directive, and to place the completed report on an agenda of this Board without committee review pursuant to rule 5.06(j) of the Board's rules of procedure. The report should describe the basic scope and responsibilities of each of the Boards listed and summarize the current state of functioning of those boards.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Oliver G. Gilbert, III. It was offered by Commissioner **Raquel A. Regalado**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Marleine Bastien** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
