RESOLUTION NO. R-571-26

RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO, AS PART OF THE PROPOSED COUNTY BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027, SEPARATELY AND CLEARLY IDENTIFY THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS OUT OF THE \$25,155,000.00 IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 COUNTY BUDGET FOR IN-KIND SERVICES RESERVE THAT ARE ANTICIPATED TO REMAIN UNUSED AND TO ALLOCATE THOSE CARRYOVER FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND WITH SPECIFICITY ON PROPOSED USES

WHEREAS, at the June 16, 2026 Board of County Commissioners' meeting, a motion was made to direct the County Mayor, as part of the proposed County budget for Fiscal Year 2026-2027, to: (1) separately and clearly identify the amount of funds that are anticipated to remain unused—and thereby available for carryover in the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 budget—out of the \$25,155,000 in funds from the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 County Budget In-Kind Services Reserve previously anticipated to be used to support public safety expenses associated with the FIFA World Cup matches to be held in Miami-Dade County; and (2) allocate those carryover funds to the general fund and specifically identify the proposed uses of same,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The recital set forth above is incorporated herein by reference and approved.

Section 2. This Board hereby directs the County Mayor, as part of the proposed County budget for Fiscal Year 2026-2027, to: (1) separately and clearly identify the amount of funds that are anticipated to remain unused—and thereby available for carryover in the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 budget—out of the \$25,155,000 in funds from the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 County Budget In-

Kind Services Reserve previously anticipated to be used to support public safety expenses associated with the FIFA World Cup matches to be held in Miami-Dade County; and (2) allocate those carryover funds to the general fund and specifically identify the proposed uses of same.
