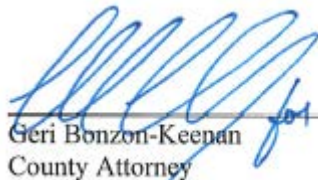

RESOLUTION APPROVING ALLOCATIONS FROM THE FY 2025-26 DISTRICT 8 CBO DISCRETIONARY RESERVE, FROM THE FY 2025-26 DISTRICT 8 DESIGNATED PROJECT PROGRAM, AND FROM THE FY 2025-26 DISTRICT 8 ARENA NAMING RIGHTS FUND; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTIONS NO. R-238-21 AND R-243-23 AS RELATED TO THE ALLOCATIONS FROM THE ARENA NAMING RIGHTS FUND

WHEREAS, this Board desires to allocate funds from the FY 2025-26 District 8 CBO Discretionary Reserve, from the FY 2025-26 District 8 Designated Project Program, and from the FY 2025-26 District 8 Arena Naming Rights Fund in accordance with the attached memorandums; and

WHEREAS, Resolutions No. R-238-21 and R-243-23 provide limitations on the use of allocations from the Arena Naming Rights Fund,
