In response to several questions related to contract award recommendations and requests for information by Commission District, please find attached a spreadsheet in alphabetical order (by organization) sorted by district.

As an update, the deadline for appealing the funding recommendations was Friday, February 25, 2011. The Clerk of the Board and the Office of Grants Coordination (OGC) received forty-three appeals; two of which were formal and forty-one that were informal appeals. Of the 308 organizations that applied for General Funds, 43 or 13.9 percent submitted an appeal. OGC is working with the County Attorney's Office to conduct a fair and impartial process by which to review and judge the merits of the appeal submissions. At the conclusion of the appeals process, I will submit an item to the full Board with findings and recommendations.
