RE: RW Part A Prescription Drug Formulary – Consumable Medical Supplies list & Allowable Medical Conditions list - Revised

Changes (effective March 18, 2019):

Consumable Medical Supplies List:

Supply Code	Description	Change	Reason
A4215	Needle, sterile any size, each	Limit was changed from a maximum of 100 per month to a maximum of 120 per month	Increasing the limit for this item allows clients who use insulin flex pens more than three times a day to have a sufficient supply of needles.

Allowable Medical Conditions:


Category	Change	Reason
CARDIOLOGY	Add the following conditions to the list: -- phlebitis -- peripheral artery disease	These are coronary conditions were identified as HIV complications not previously listed.

Category	Change	Reason
DERMATOLOGY	Add the following conditions to the list: -- impetigo -- methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA)	These bacterial conditions were identified as HIV complications not previously listed.

As a reminder the Ryan White Program is the payer of last resort. If a client qualifies for and can access these items or services through any other payer source, the client must use those sources first.
