The purpose of the hearing is to allow the public an opportunity to comment on the following:

- Substantial amendment to the FY 2021 Action Plan and corresponding FY 2020-24 Consolidated Plan in order to allocate \$2,005,000.00 of Home Investment Partnerships Program Income to Pinnacle at Tropical Pointe, LLC, or related entity, for the development of Pinnacle at Tropical Pointe, a 215-unit affordable housing community located at the intersection of SW 252nd Street and SW 137th Avenue, in unincorporated Miami-Dade County, Florida, in Commission District 8.
