Your eye doctor, an ophthalmologist or optometrist, can examine the retina for signs of eye disease, including diabetic retinopathy.

If diabetic retinopathy is detected, it can be treated with laser surgery. While there is no cure for diabetes, it can be managed. Proper medication, close monitoring of blood sugar levels, a healthy diet and regular exercise can help and reduce the likelihood of vision-related complications.





## **Know the symptoms**

The early symptoms of diabetic retinopathy may be hard to detect. According to the National Eye Institute, you may experience changes in your vision (blurry vision, floating spots) or have difficulty reading or seeing faraway objects.
