Continue to provide high level of benefits to our employees

MIAMI·DADE

- Review of Affordable Care Act
 - MDC equivalent to "Platinum Plan" at 91.6% vs. Minimum Essential Coverage required at 60% or "Bronze Plan"
 - Biweekly cost for <u>Individual</u> Age 50 for a "Platinum HMO Plan" can range from (\$229.63 – \$293.15)
 - Benefit changes required as a result of healthcare reform
 - Out of pocket maximums
 - Affordable Care Act Excise Tax (Penalties in 2018)



- Review of MDC/JHS Enrollment/Utilization
 - Approximately 60,000 Lives
 - Single Coverage Premium for most plans is \$0
 - (POS \$14.90 biweekly)
 - Approximately 62% of MDC employees have single coverage
- "Select" Plan offered to Jackson Employees
 - Offers same benefits as HMO High
 - Lower Premiums for Family Coverage
 - Limited Providers
 - 70% of Physicians are in Select Network

Shifting Services to More Efficient Settings

- Select Network
 - If 25% migration... \$8M Savings
- Emergency Room vs. Urgent Care Centers
 - If 60% migration... \$847K Savings
- Jackson vs. Other Facilities
 - If 25% migration... \$19M Savings
 - If 100% migration... \$76.9M Savings
- Advanced Imaging (Free Standing Facilities vs. Hospitals)
 - If 60% migration... \$2.2M Savings
