

Challenge Begins- January 1, 2021  
Registration Period- September 14 – November 15



## **Official Rules:**

1. Only the first 40 teams of 20 to register will be enrolled in the Challenge. All eligible team entries must be submitted to [WellnessWorks@miamidade.gov](mailto:WellnessWorks@miamidade.gov).
2. A minimum of 18 individuals must be included in team to be considered a complete team.
3. Once registration has been submitted, there can be no changes, substitutions or additions to the team participants.
4. All team members must be eligible and active on the County's health plan, AvMed, and within HealthyRoads at time of registration.
5. Once the Challenge begins, if a team member withdraws from the Challenge they cannot be added back to a team.
6. This 2021 Walk Around the World Pole to Pole Challenge is a walking challenge. All activities will be converted to steps. The Challenge has a stop gap programmed for all participants. There is a daily maximum of steps/miles (87,500 steps/ 35 miles) that will be recorded by each individual for the duration of the Challenge.
7. MDC WellnessWorks is not responsible for replacing any lost or damaged connected devices. Each individual is responsible for maintaining or replacing their connected device. Additional devices, if needed, can be purchased at a discount through the health plan and Choose Healthy Discount Program. Participants can log into their AvMed account and click Health and Wellness then select the Alternative Medicine and Discount Program tile to access the discount page.

### **9. Team Captain Responsibilities**

- Submitting a complete registration form inclusive of accurate team member information.
- Maintaining constant communication with team to relay Challenge information and updates as well as assisting with coordination and distribution of Challenge items to team.
- Monitoring team and discouraging any fraudulent activities by team members. Any fraudulent manual steps/miles entries are grounds for disqualification of the entire team.
