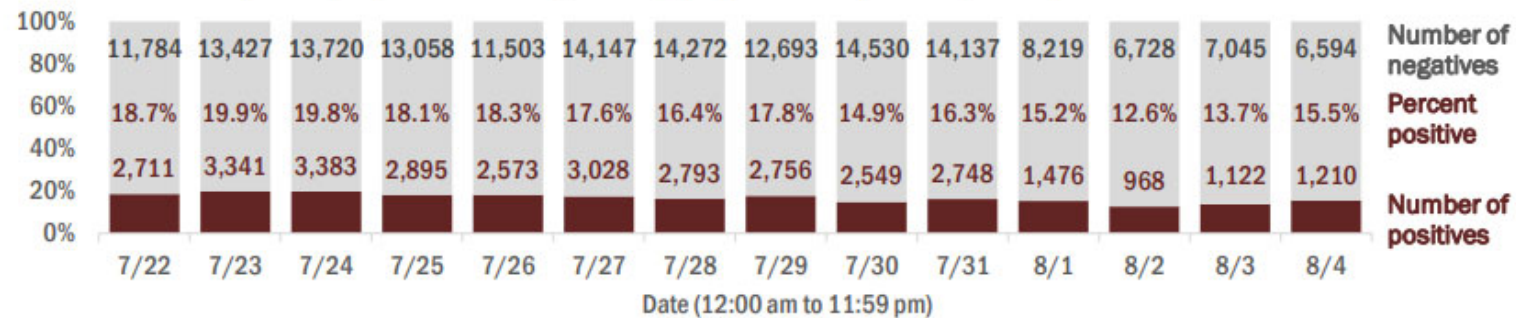

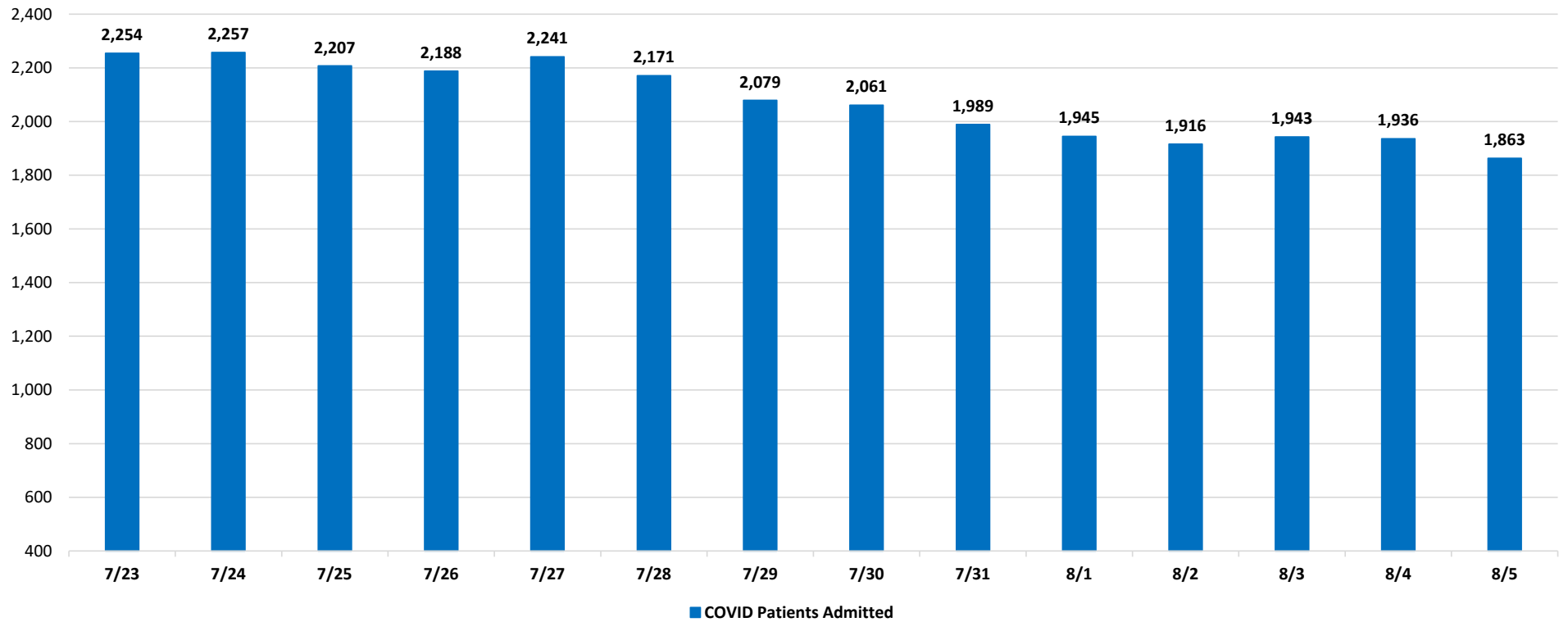

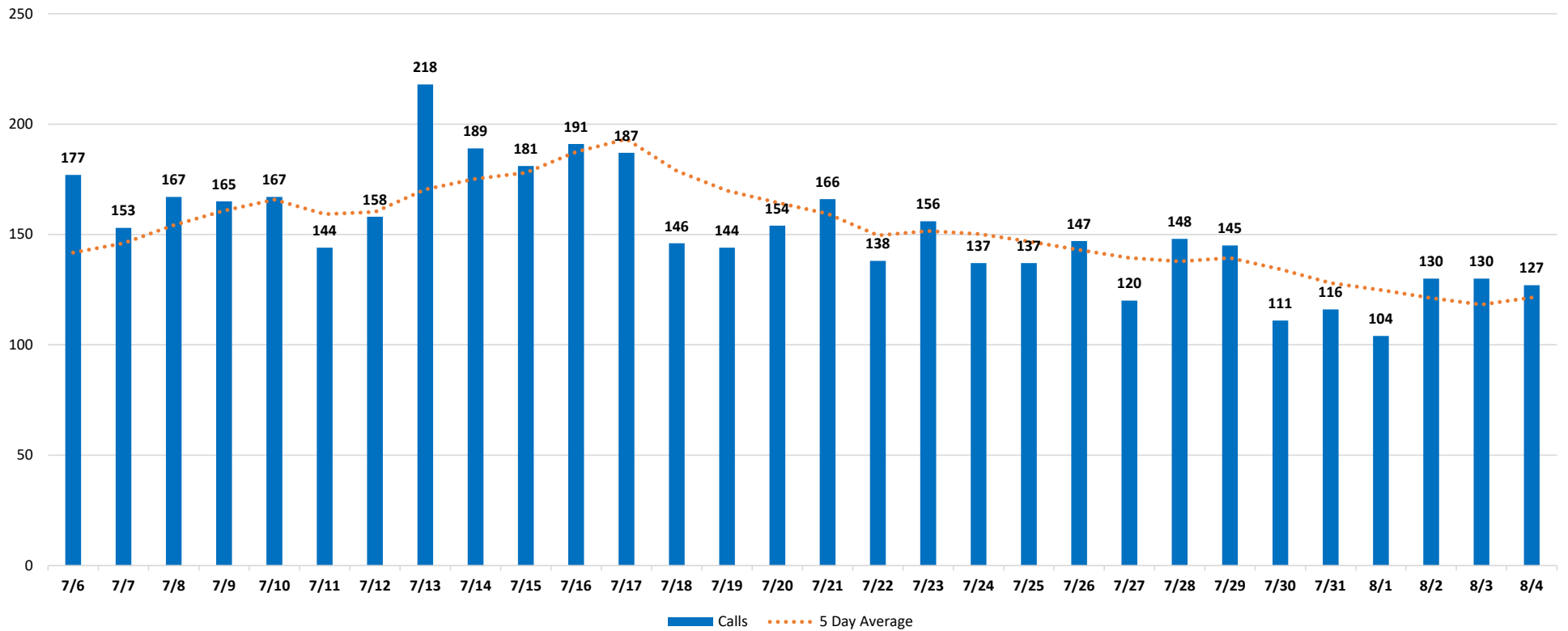

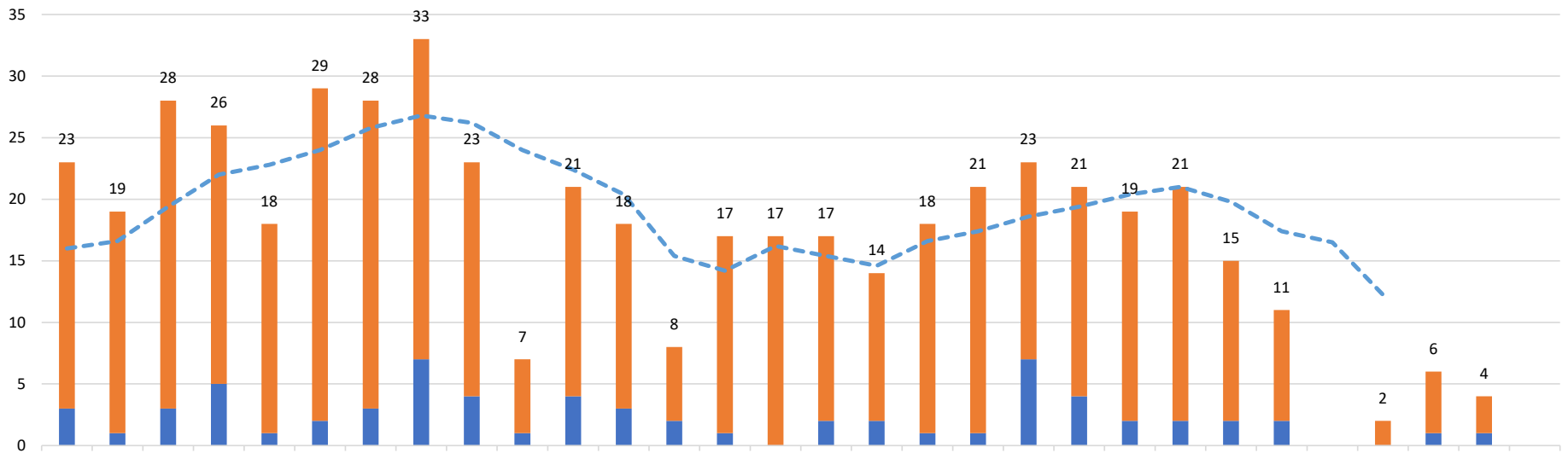
MDFR Suspected COVID-19 Calls
