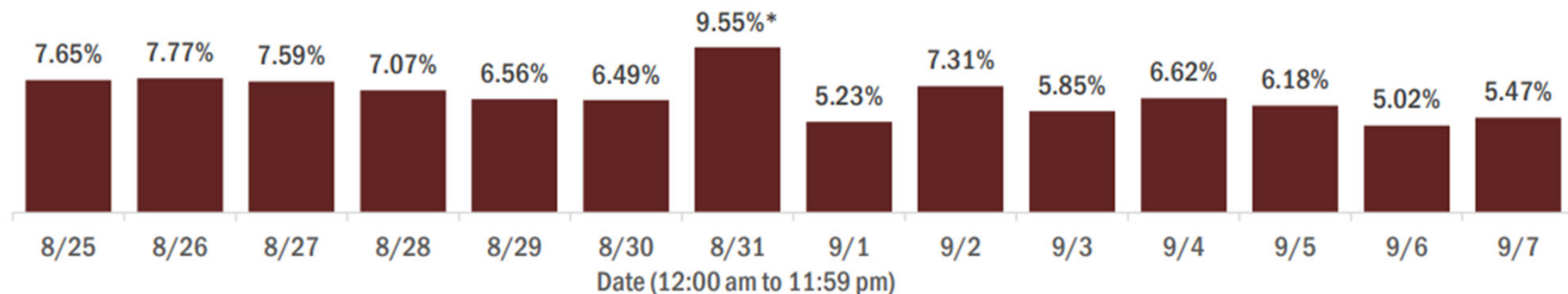

Percent positivity for new cases in Florida residents

These counts include the number of Florida residents for whom the department received PCR or antigen laboratory results by day. This percent is the number of people who test positive for the first time divided by all the people tested that day, excluding people who have previously tested positive.



* Includes a one-time historical data submission from a large laboratory that affected some counties. The percent positivity on 8/31 excluding the historical data submission was 7.90%.

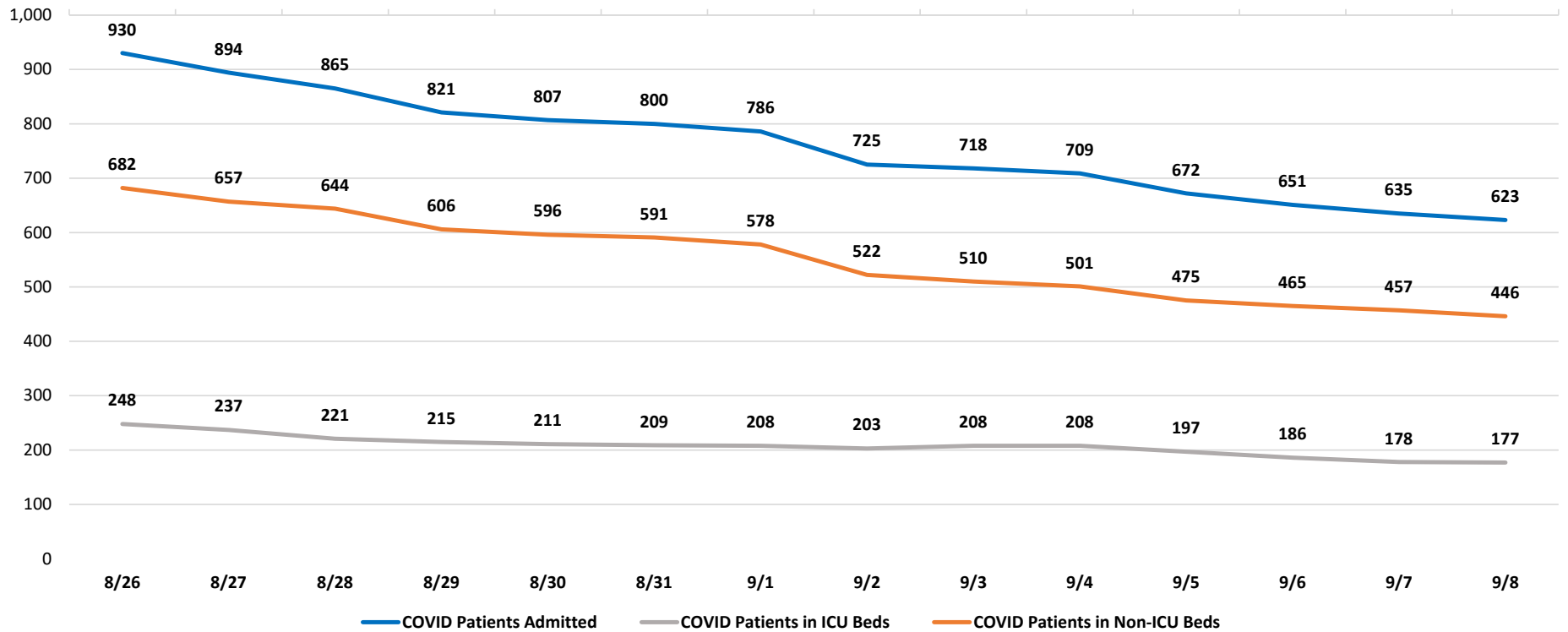

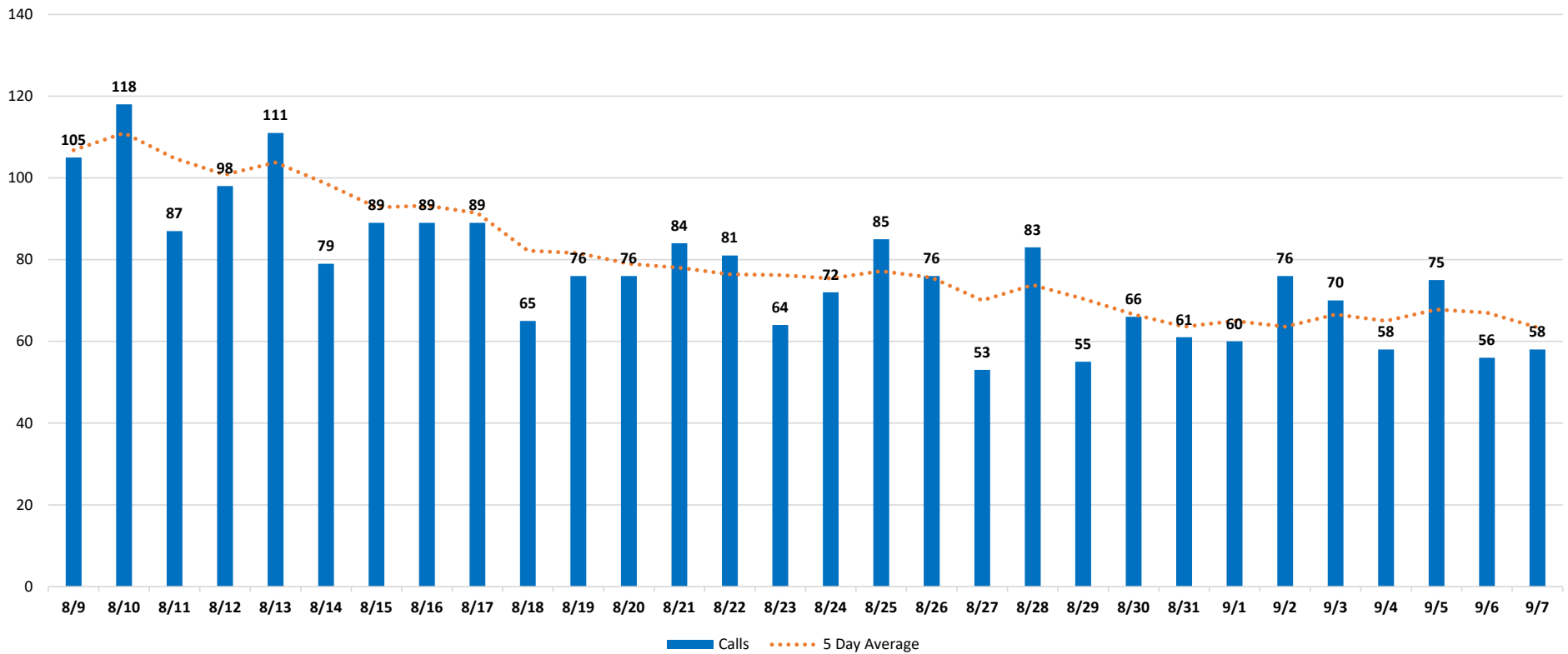

MDFR Suspected COVID-19 Calls

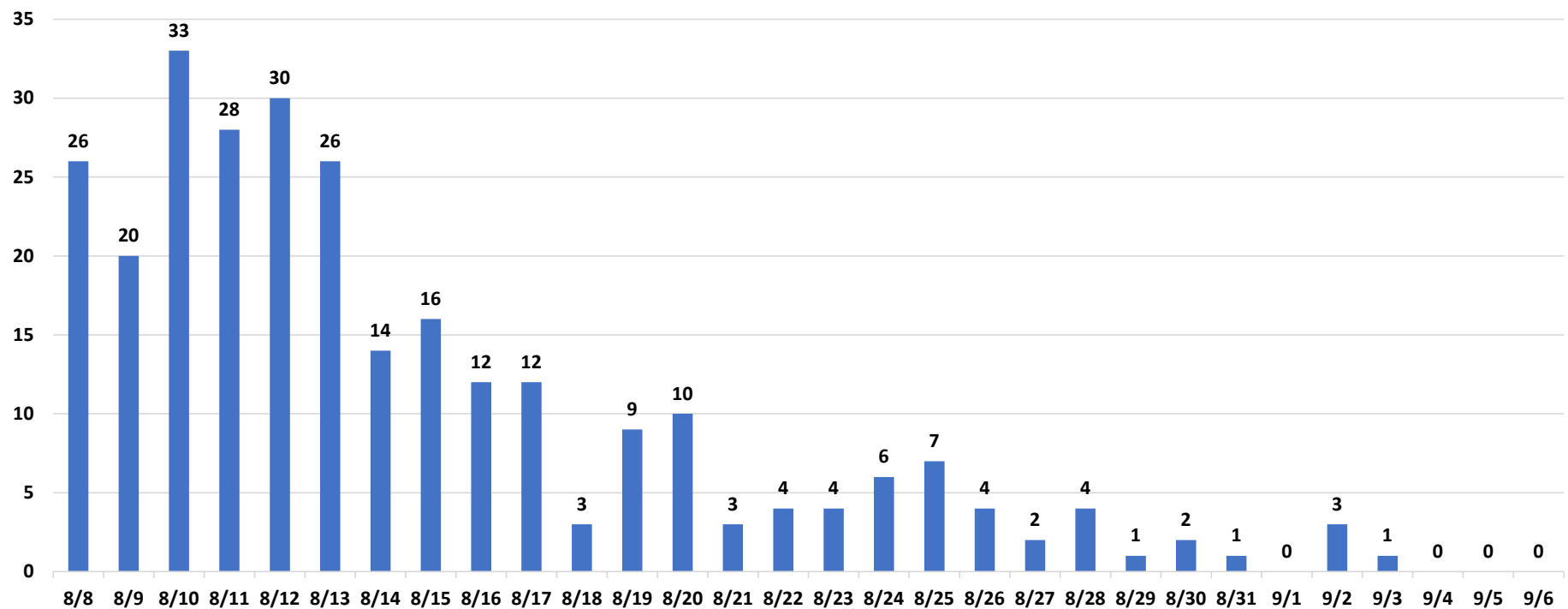

An August 15th decision by the Florida Medical Examiner Commission determined that "treating physicians may certify COVID-19 deaths" so long as certain conditions are met. While this decision will expedite such process, it will result in the County's ME reporting and certifying a lower number of deaths. Beginning today, the deaths shown are based on figures provided by the Florida Department of Health.
